Step 3



- Choose English courses in your planner. You must have 4 English credits to graduate.
- Look through the social studies course descriptions and choose one (if needed). You must have 3 social studies credits to graduate.
 - Civics/Economics
 - World History
 - U.S. History

- Double check that other requirements are in your course plan

FAQ's

1. Q: What if my career path is not listed?

A: Make sure to look through each pathway before making that determination. Would it benefit you to follow an AP or Concurrent courses pathway? You can select, "Skip this step".

2. Q: Where do I find electives?

A: At the bottom of your course planner where it is titled, "Diploma pathways and additional electives".

3. Q: Why do I have to create an SSP?

A: You are picking your courses for next year and, ideally, your remaining years at SHS.

4. Q: Do I need to talk to my parents about my chosen classes?

A: Yes! Your parents can give you valuable information and help you choose the right classes.

5. Q: I am worried I am not choosing the right classes. What do I do?

A: Look at the course catalog on page 1. Review the classes you have taken and what else you need to take. That should be your guide. You will meet one-on-one with your counselors, soon.
