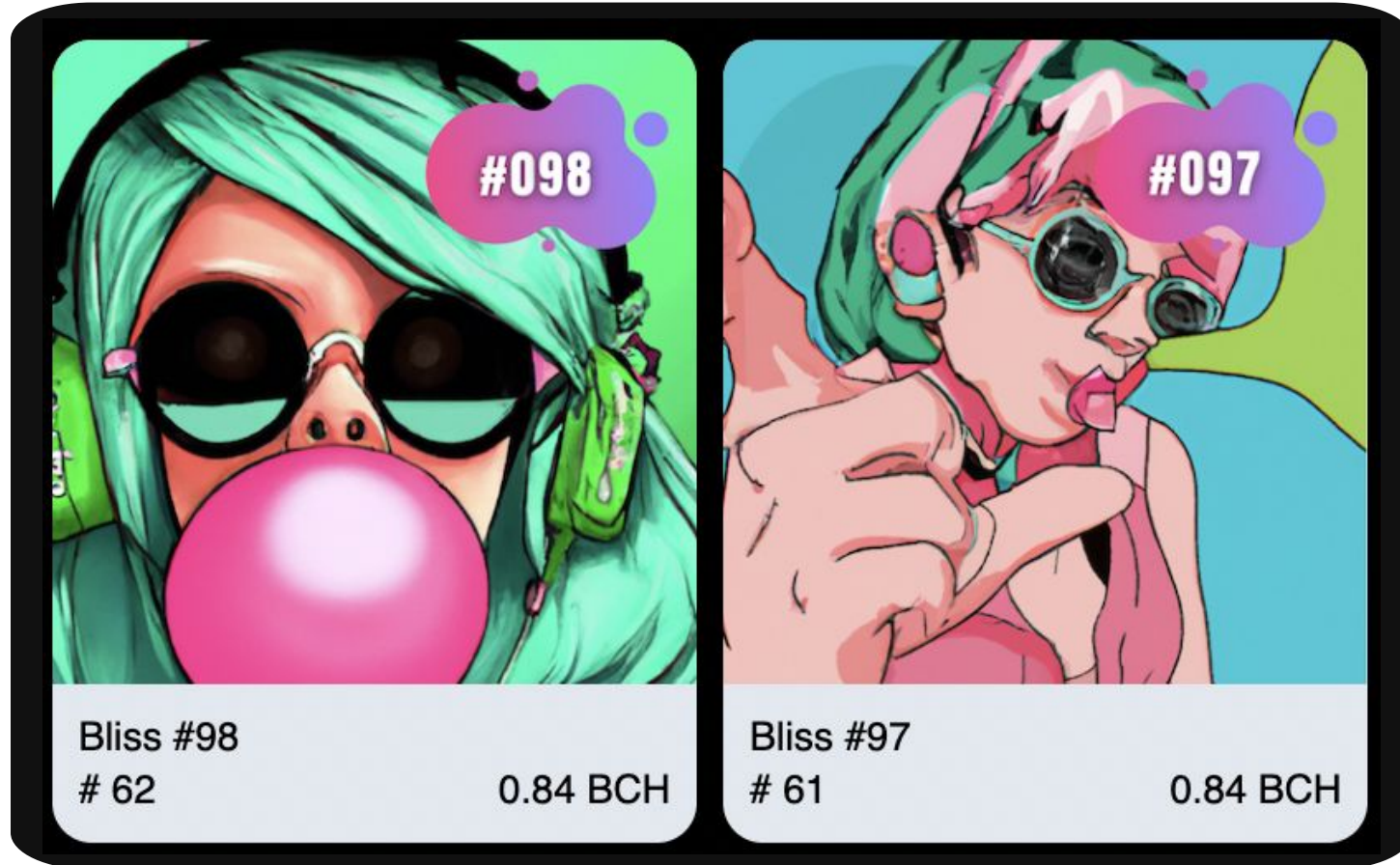

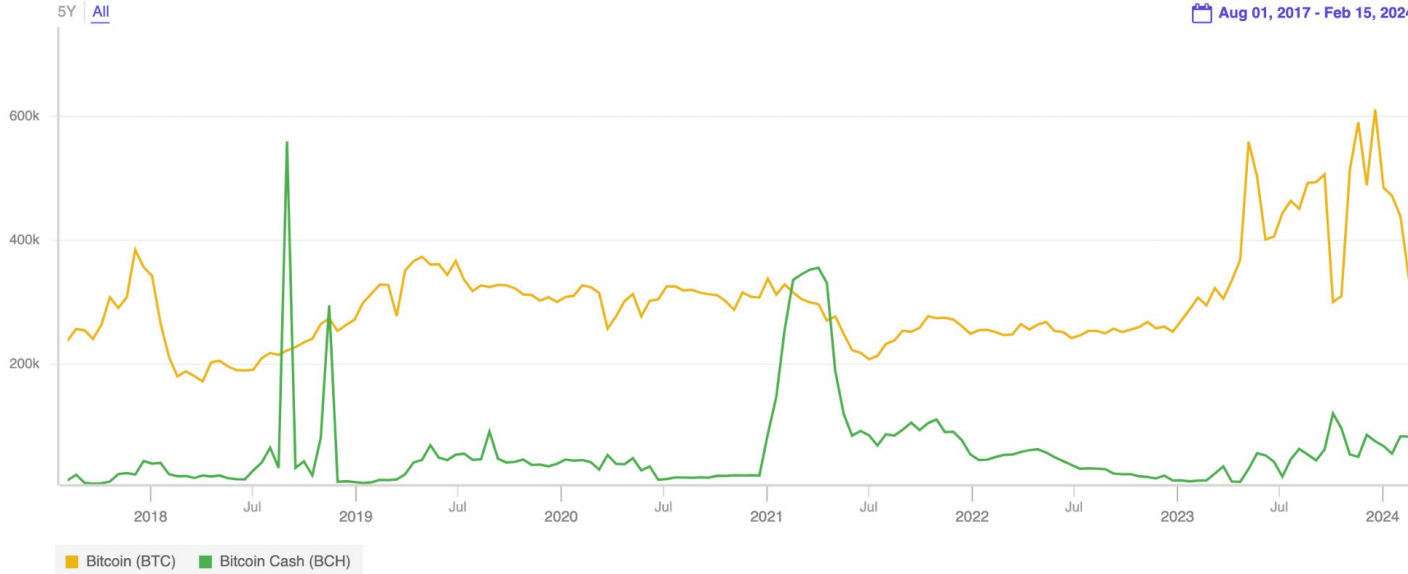

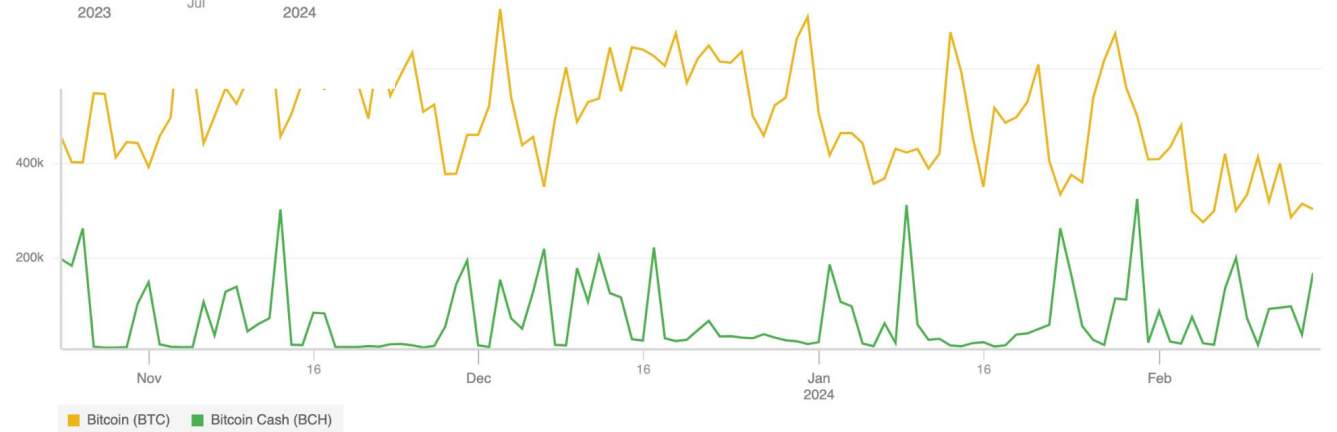

As you know, we permanently booted the components market at the end of November and presently build applications whereby every supplier is paid cash for every component they supply (something not possible with any other cryptocurrency). While the tech has taken the long road to market, we wanted the integrity of building our tech/infrastructure using components.

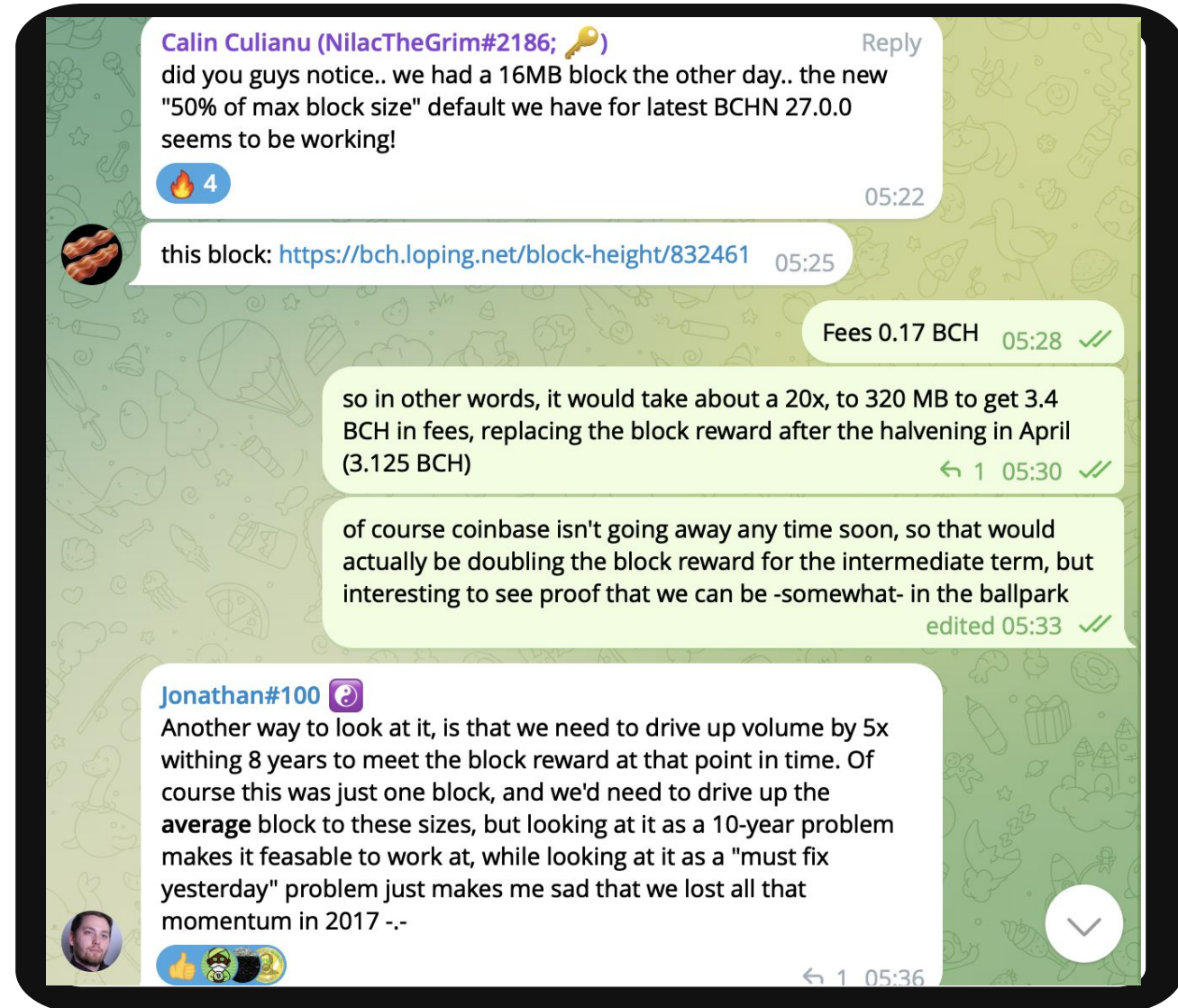






# CHIP: Saturday Upgrades Only

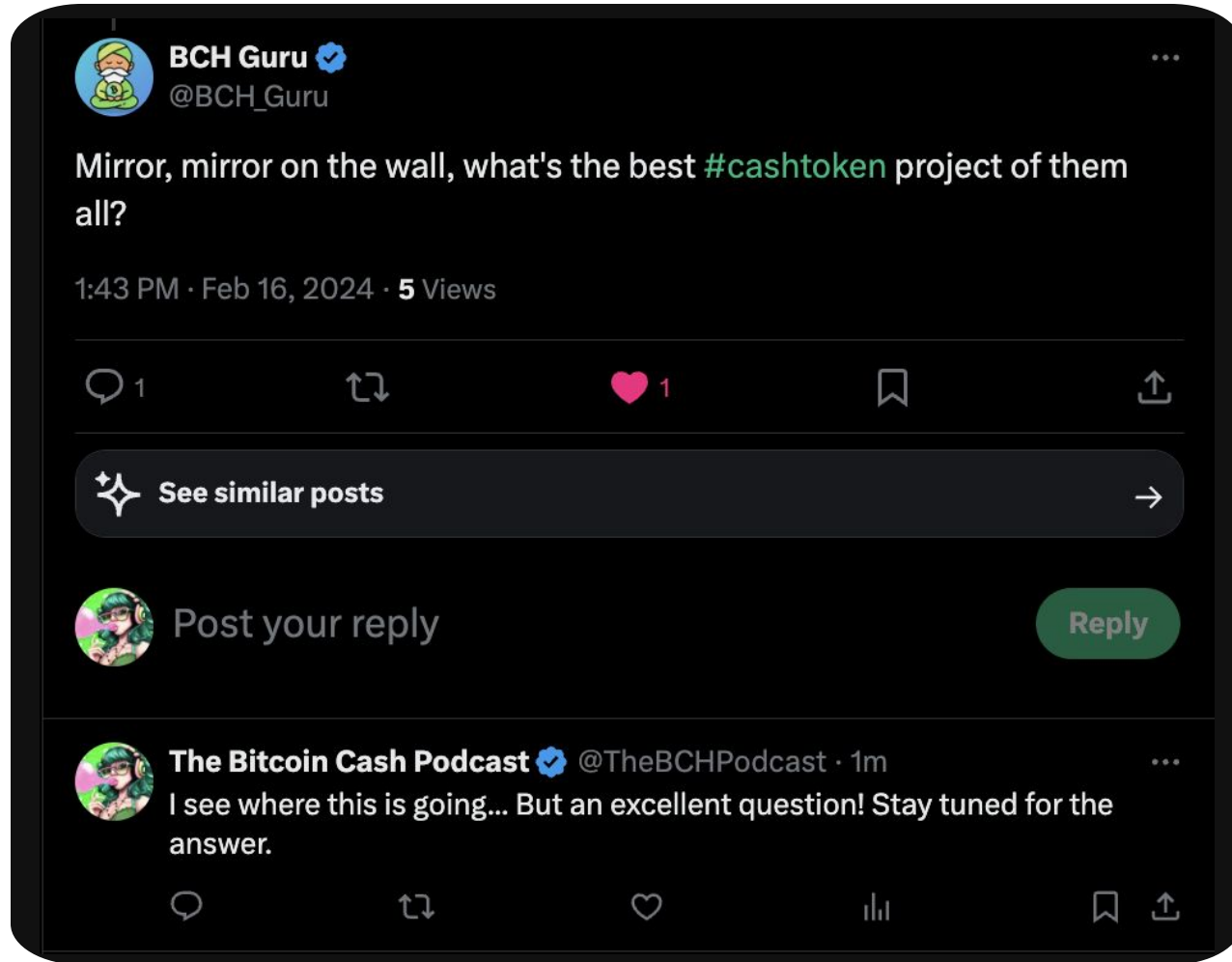
- Alex and I proposed a CHIP to

- Response was mixed:
  - Promotion minded individuals found it a slam dunk
  - Engineers found it inconvenient for their weekend relaxation
  - Concerns were raised about the benefit & co-ordination costs
- Lessons learnt?

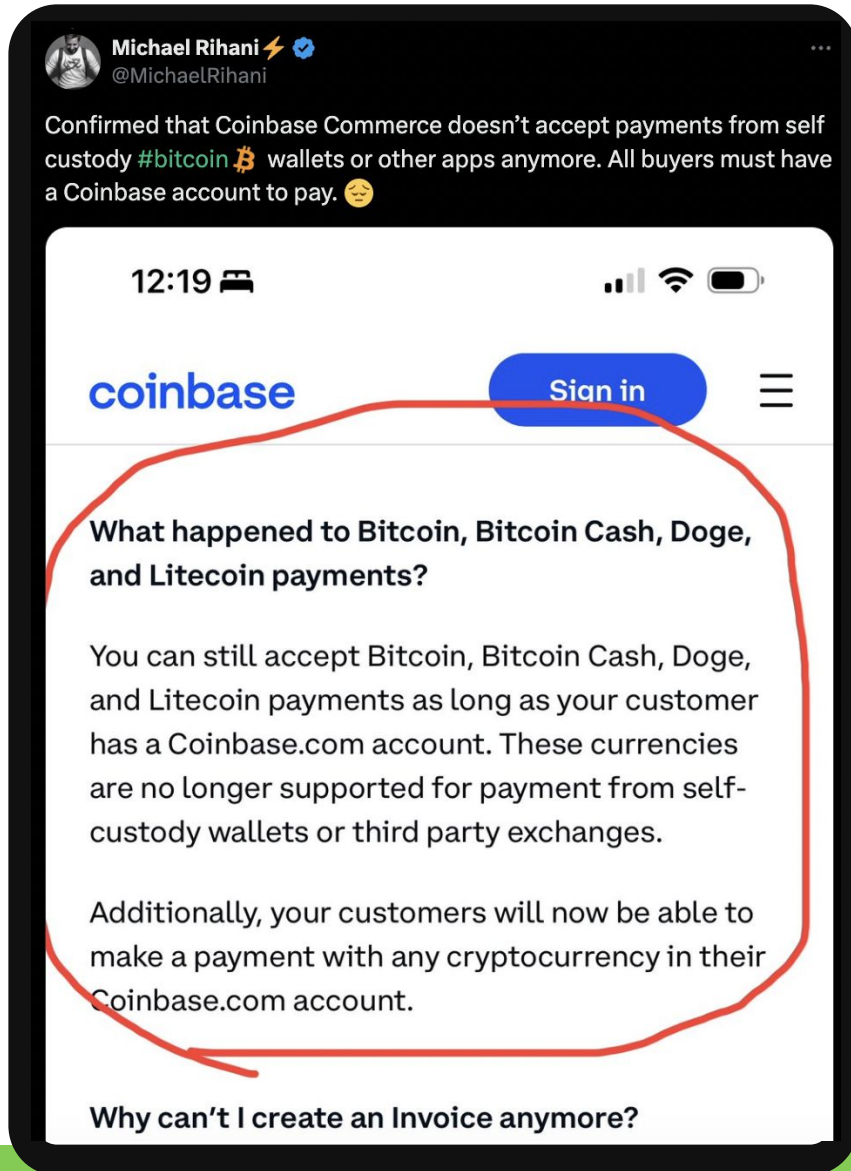

# Custodybase

- Coinbase implementing a change that cuts off non-custodial payments to BCH, BTC, LTC, DOGE payments. EVM chains preferred
- Ongoing transition to reskinned PayPal

- This is their “solution” for making instant, cheap “crypto” payments & compete with legacy.

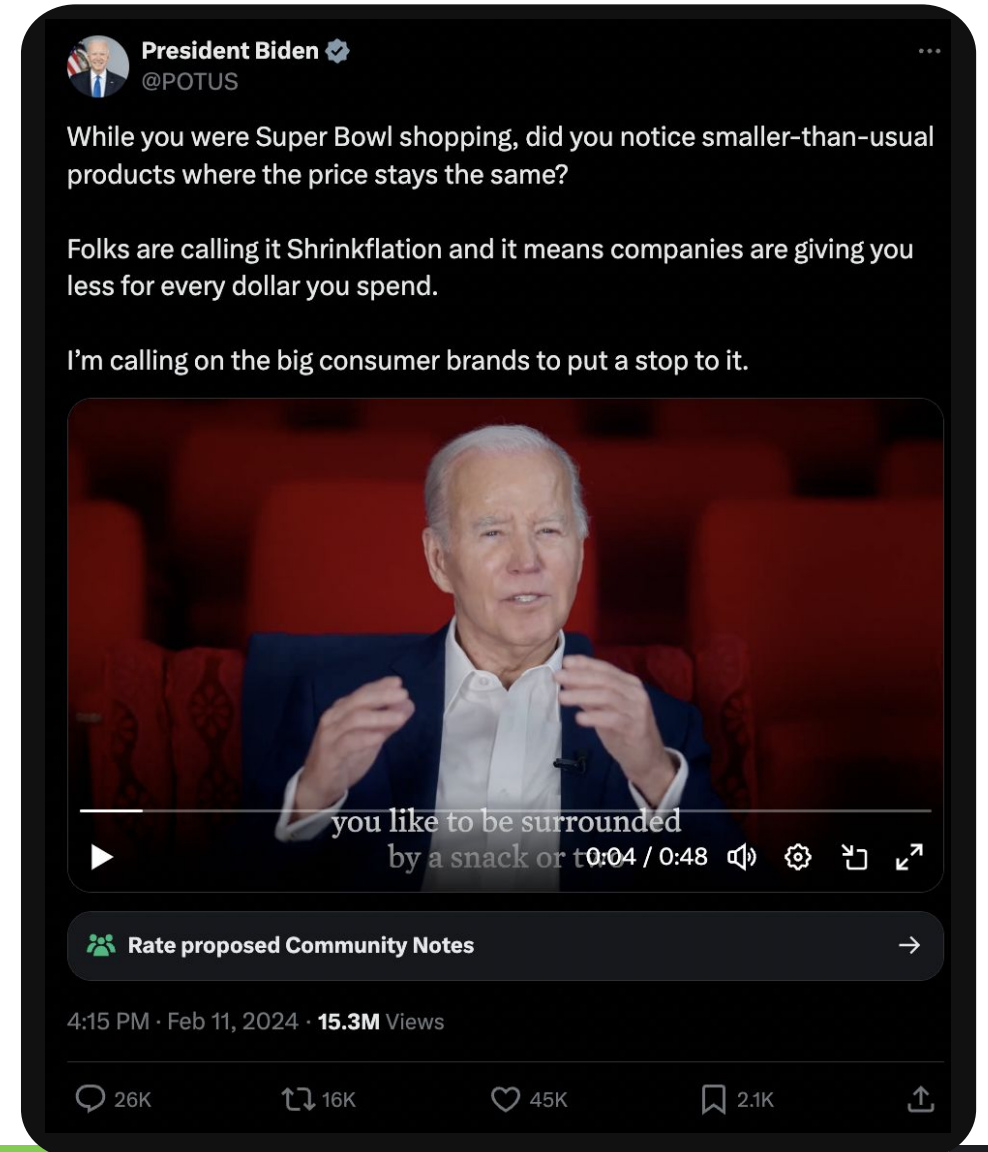

# COPA vs CSW

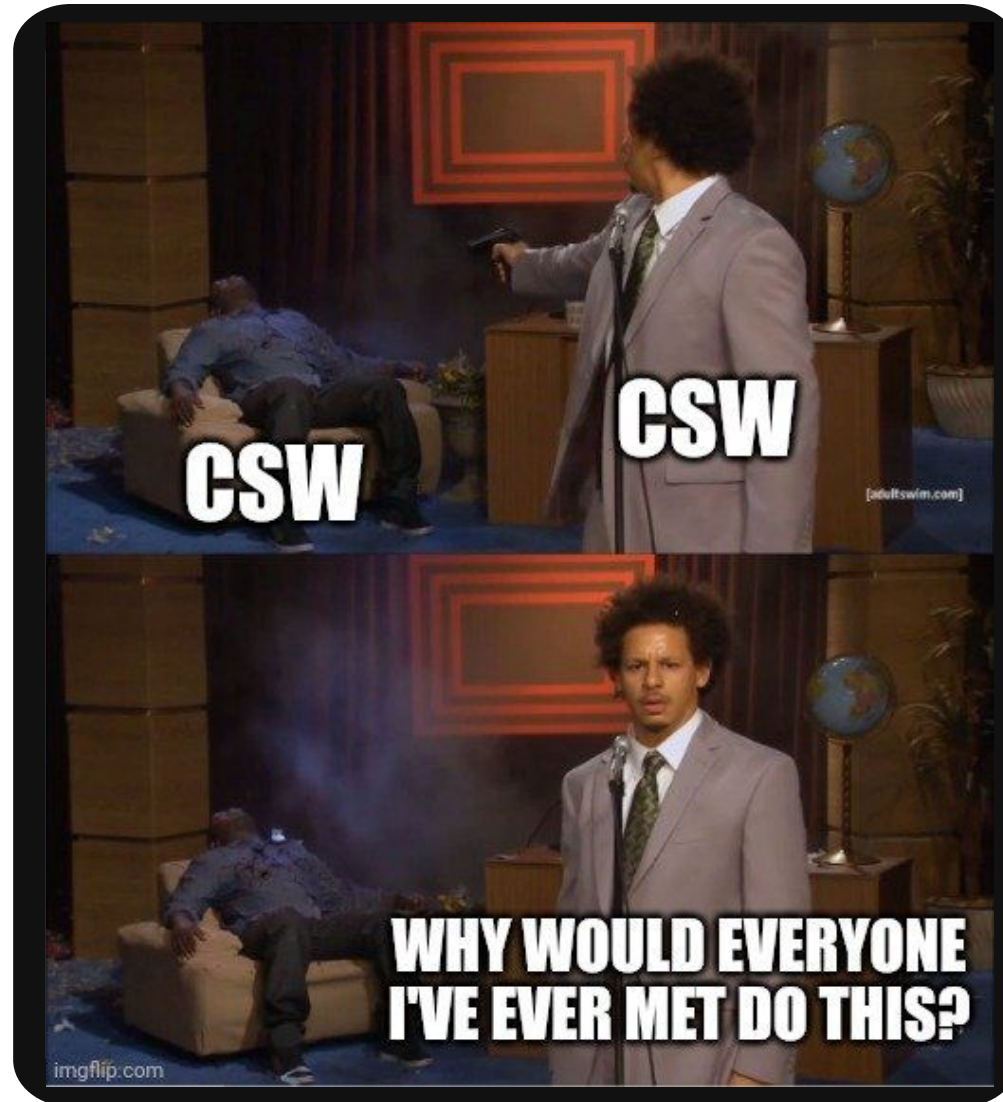
- Avalanche of exposed lies, contradictions, forged documents
