Code for All is

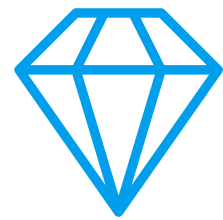
- A distributed network where decisions are made collectively

Code for All is not

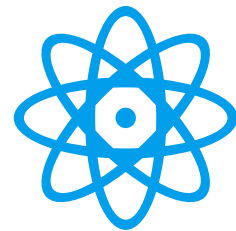
- All about writing code

Global Impact



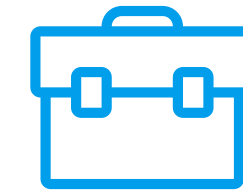
Innovate

Advocate

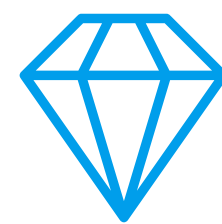
We are the biggest advocacy body in civic tech, representing organizations from around the world on the global stage.

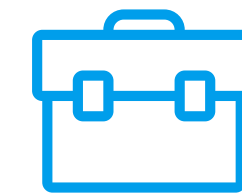

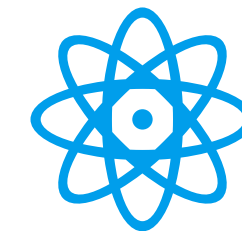

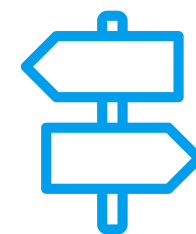

Every year we come together to learn and strategize



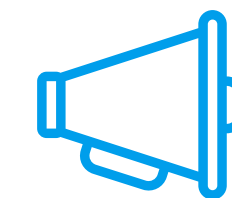

Code for Romania created a tool to catch voting irregularities which is being replicated across the region.

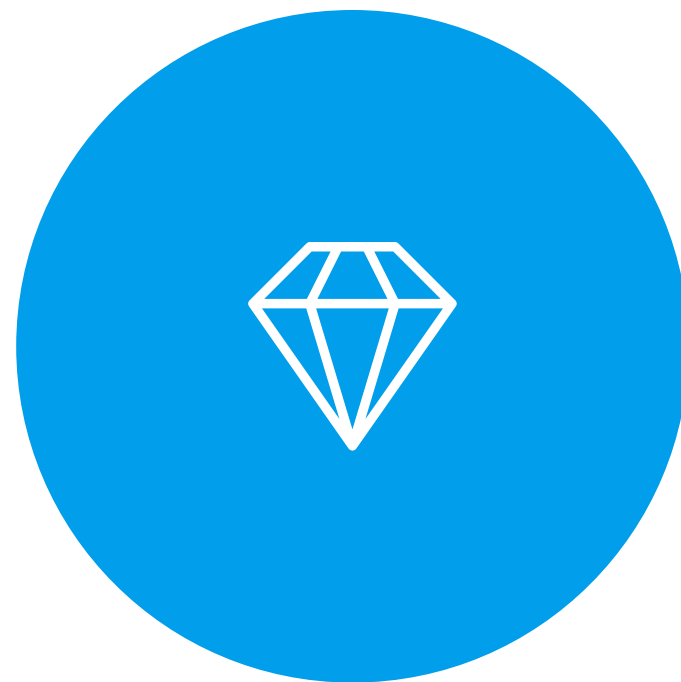


Open Everything

Countless projects are working on open data and open legislation, from South Africa to Poland.

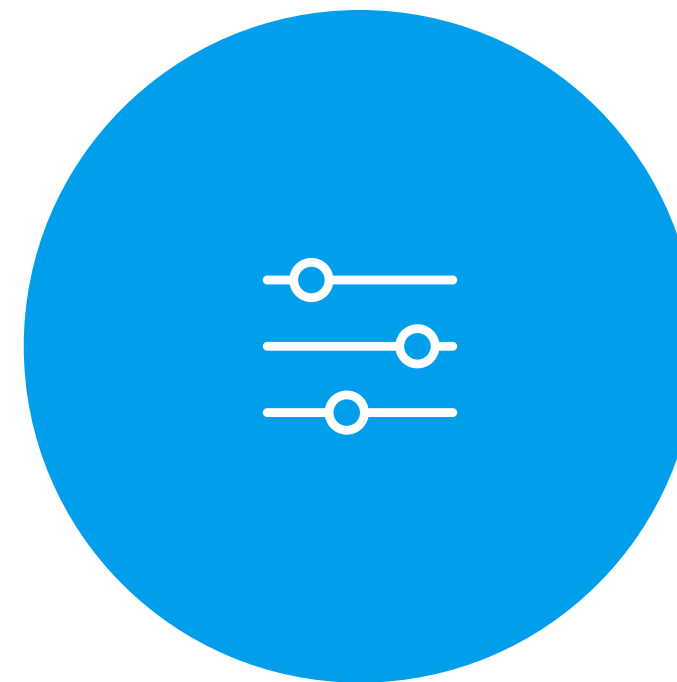

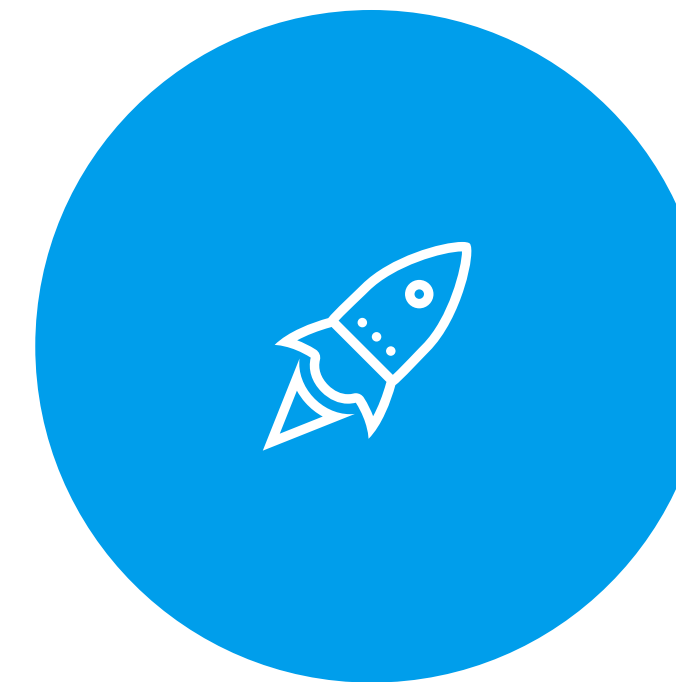
Create Opportunities

Scale What Works

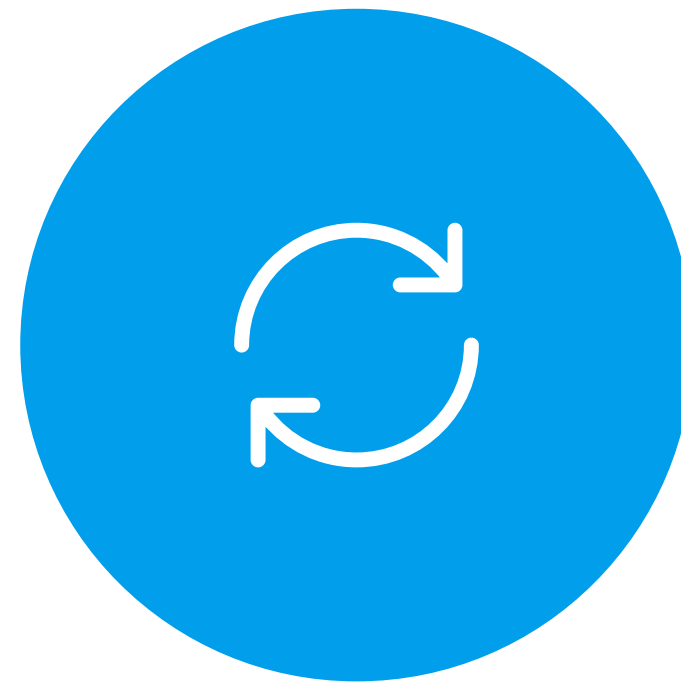
We want to grow the network for impact, equipping new members with proven tools methods and programs.

Shape The Future

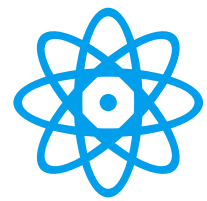
We actively consult all members about the operations of Code for All, strategic decisions and the long-term direction of opportunities and funding.
