# Can chatgpt be considered an academic search tool?

## Library databases



- Specialized academic search tools
- Can be subject-specific
- Offers advanced and specialized search options
- Indexed and reviewed contents

## Google scholar



- An index of webpages with mostly scholarly content, including articles and dissertations
- List-based results
- Crawls as widely as possible and ranks results based on factors such as popularity

## chatgpt



- A chatbot
- Conversation-based results
- Imitates how a human writes based on large sets of training data ( dataset up until 2021 only)
