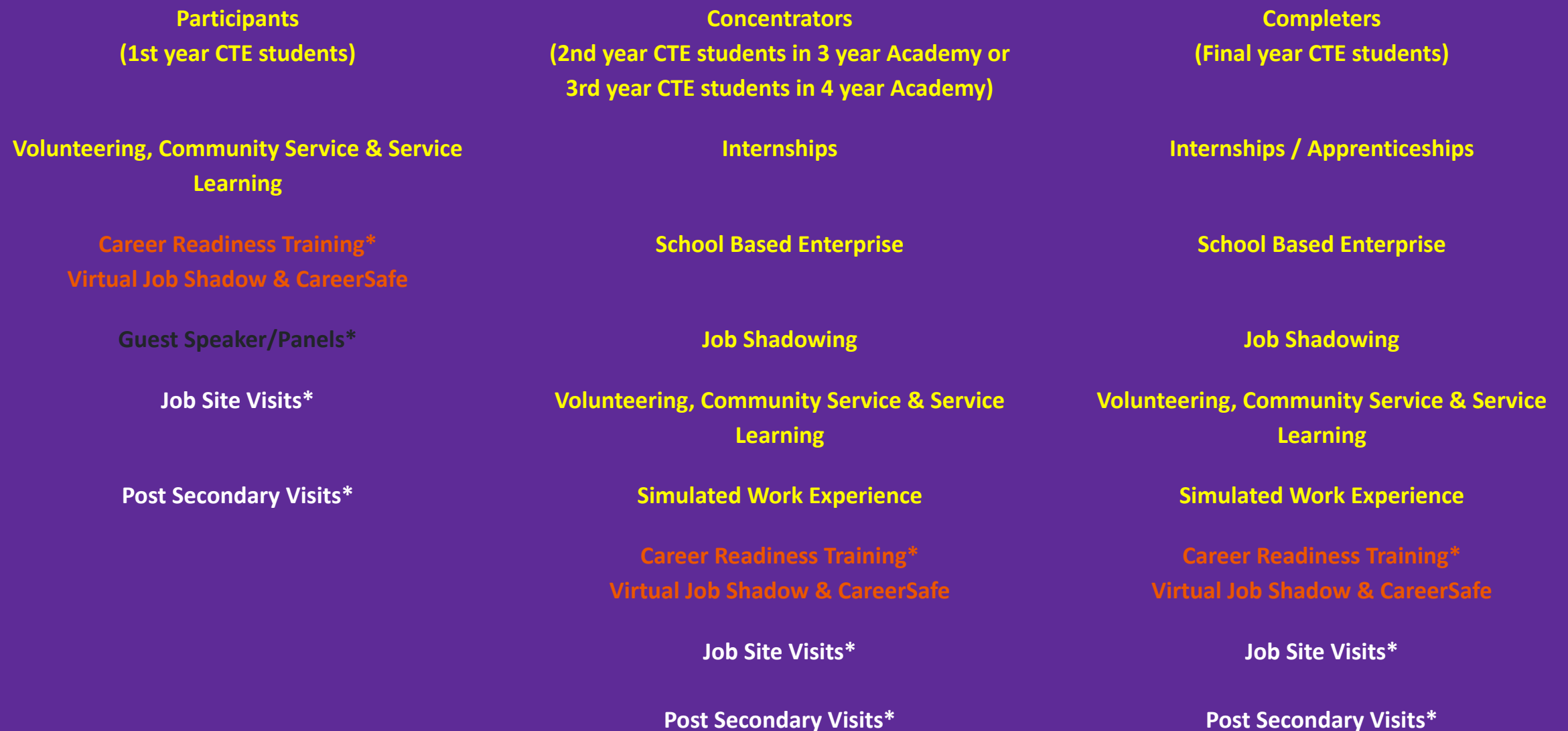

SCHOOLS THAT CAN FACILITATED WORKSHOPS

IN-CLASS WORKSHOPS (1 PER WEEK)

These workshops will focus on resume building and interview preparation. Curriculum will be provided by STC and will be shared with teachers prior to the scheduled workshop.

RESUME BUILDING

STUDENTS WILL COMPLETE A FULL RESUME

Completed resume will be edited by an area professional who will volunteer to review it.

MOCK INTERVIEWS

VIRTUAL OR IN-PERSON

1-2 mock interview sessions for students with area professionals who volunteer to interview students.

EXTERNSHIP DAY

JOB SHADOW/EXTERNSHIP DAY

Includes career survey several weeks in advance, at least one workshop to prepare students, then a one-day excursion for students to externship sites.
