


Abby Sanders: The Ultimate Real- Estate Experience






Thijs Larson: Cardiology Shadowing: Lab and Clinical





Sophia Scott: Target Product Design and Development Project


So in the end, Capstone allowed me to decide what I **don't** want to do but also what I **do** want to do.




Jack Mingus: GFS Capstone Greenhouse and Aquaponics









Tasha (Nisita) O'Donnell: Job Shadowing at Treat and Company (Design Firm)

Alexis Macuna: Real Estate (Edina Realty)


This experience will have a long lasting impact on my future career. I've been fortunate to make remarkable memories that will last forever.




I'm so grateful for the opportunity to shadow Dana and Kara. They have taught me so much that I can use in my future schooling.


Viktor Boris: Medicinal Chemistry Shadowing at the Wagner Research Group
