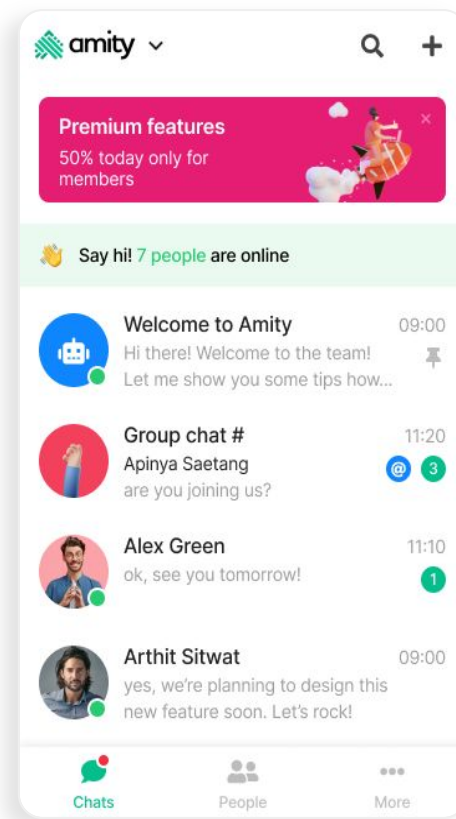


## Eko 15.1

The function to mention all member in a group chat is applicable when there are not more than 50 people in a group chat. All of group members will see @ sign when they are mentioned.

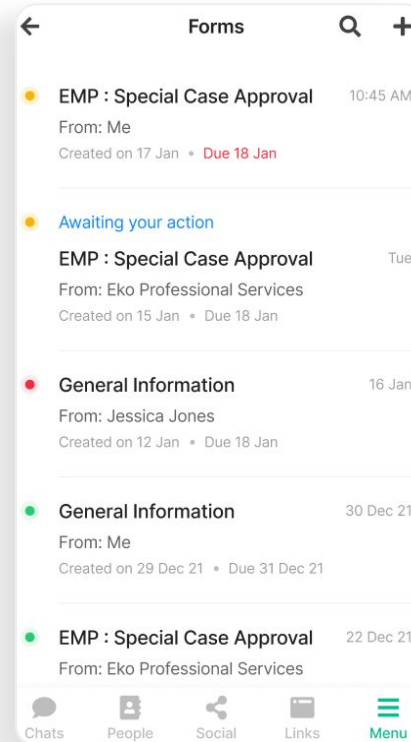
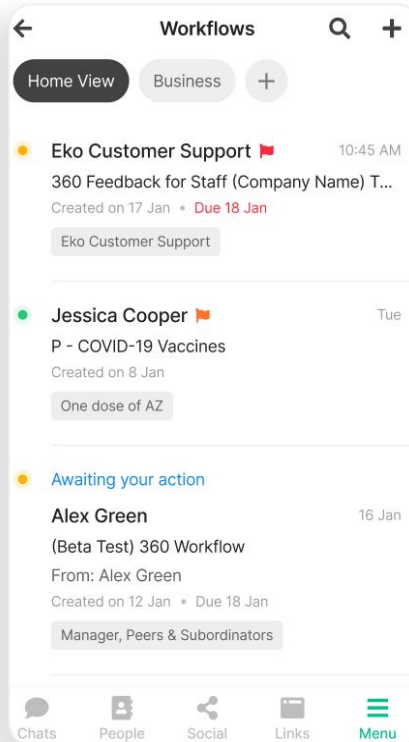

Form status color is at the front of form title, together with form creation date under form creator. The design is applied to mobile and web app.

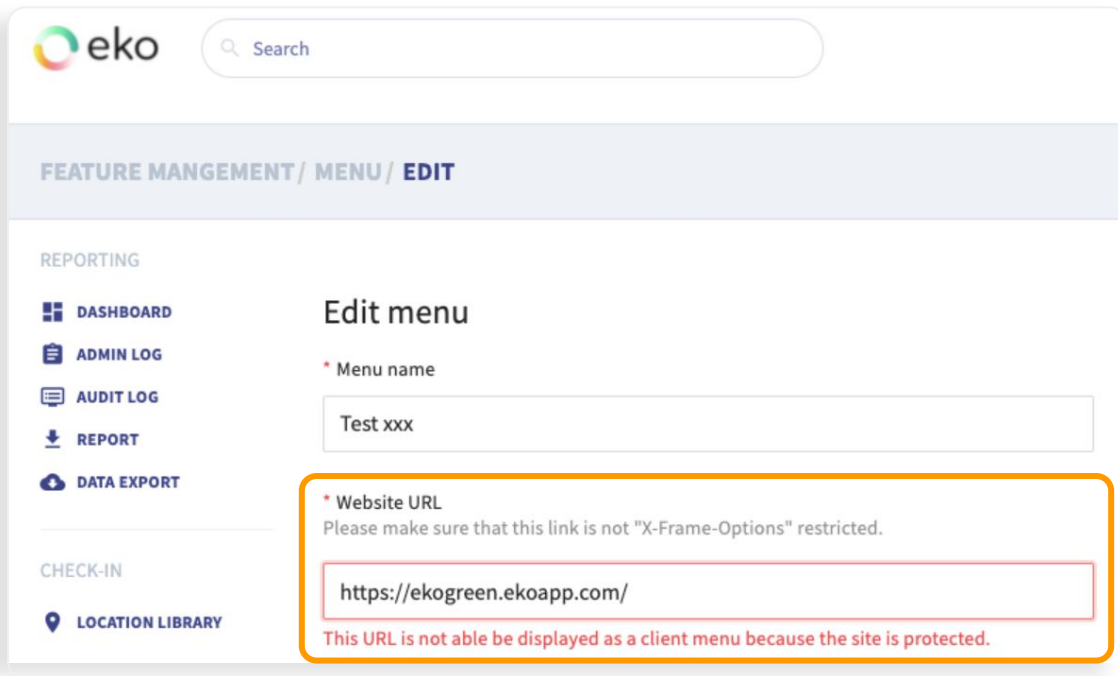


## Eko 15.1

### Enhancement

- **Client Menu URL's iframe protection check**

If a URL that protected from iframe is added to Menu, admin will receive a warning message that a URL is iframe protected and cannot be displayed on Client Menu.

## Enhancement

- **Directory group member validation on Workflows**

Workflow can now validate member in directory group on parallel workflow stage. If an admin requires number of assignee or approval that exceeds actual number of member in directory group, workflow will show red underline to notify an admin.
