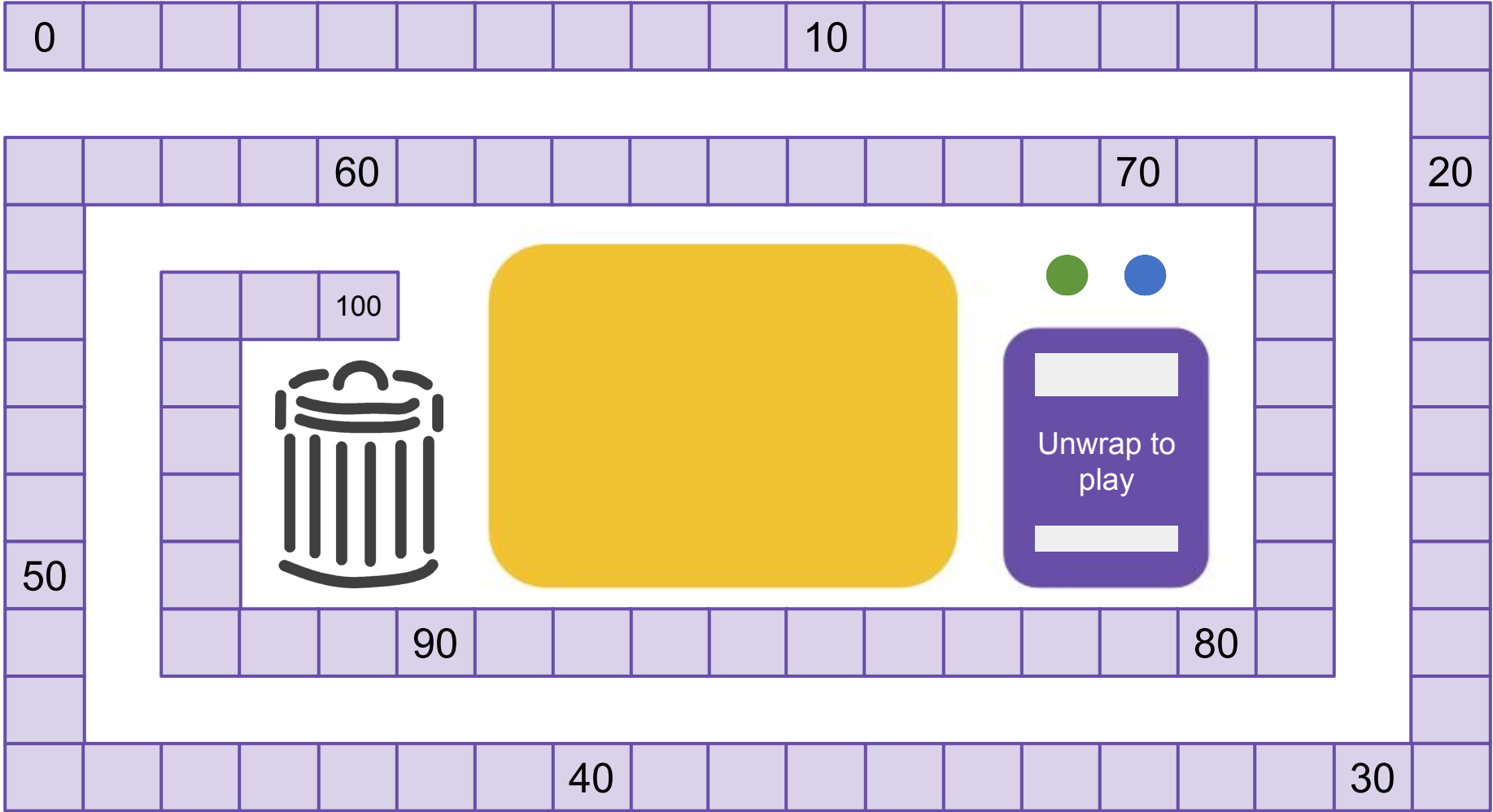
The next 12 slides are games ready to drag and drop directly in your slides. Each slide contains a different “random” deck. Change them up so that it appears random.

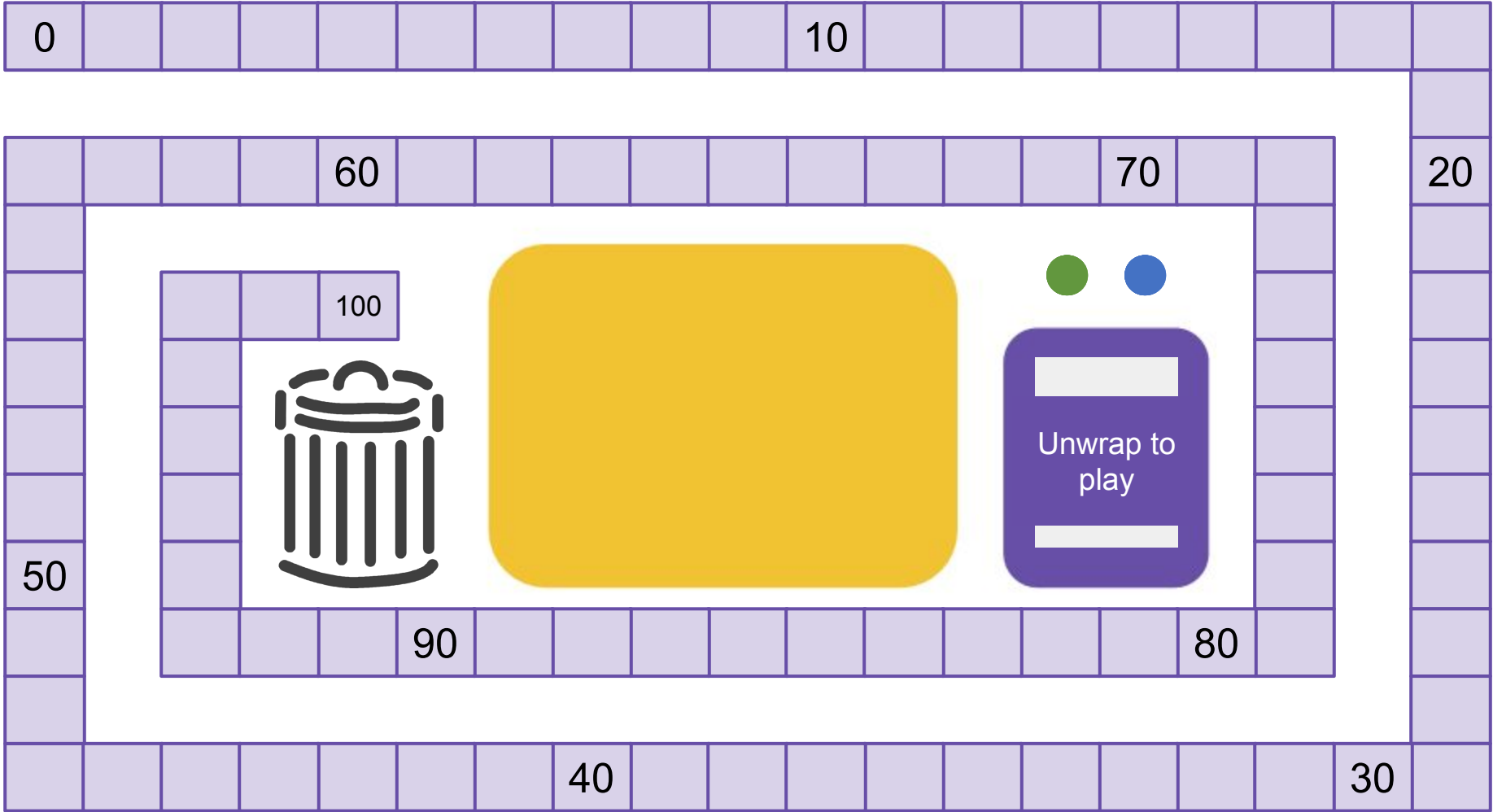




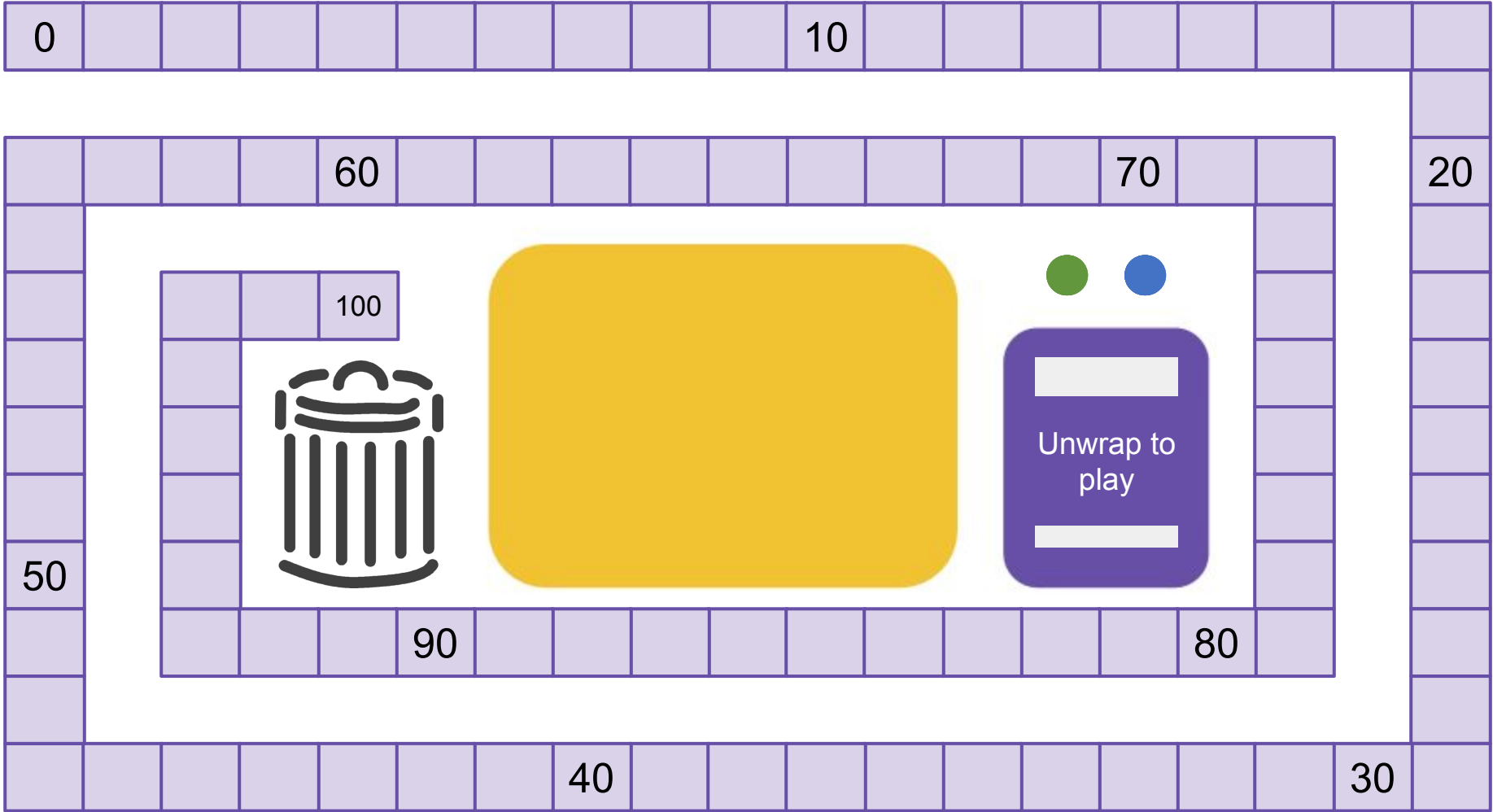


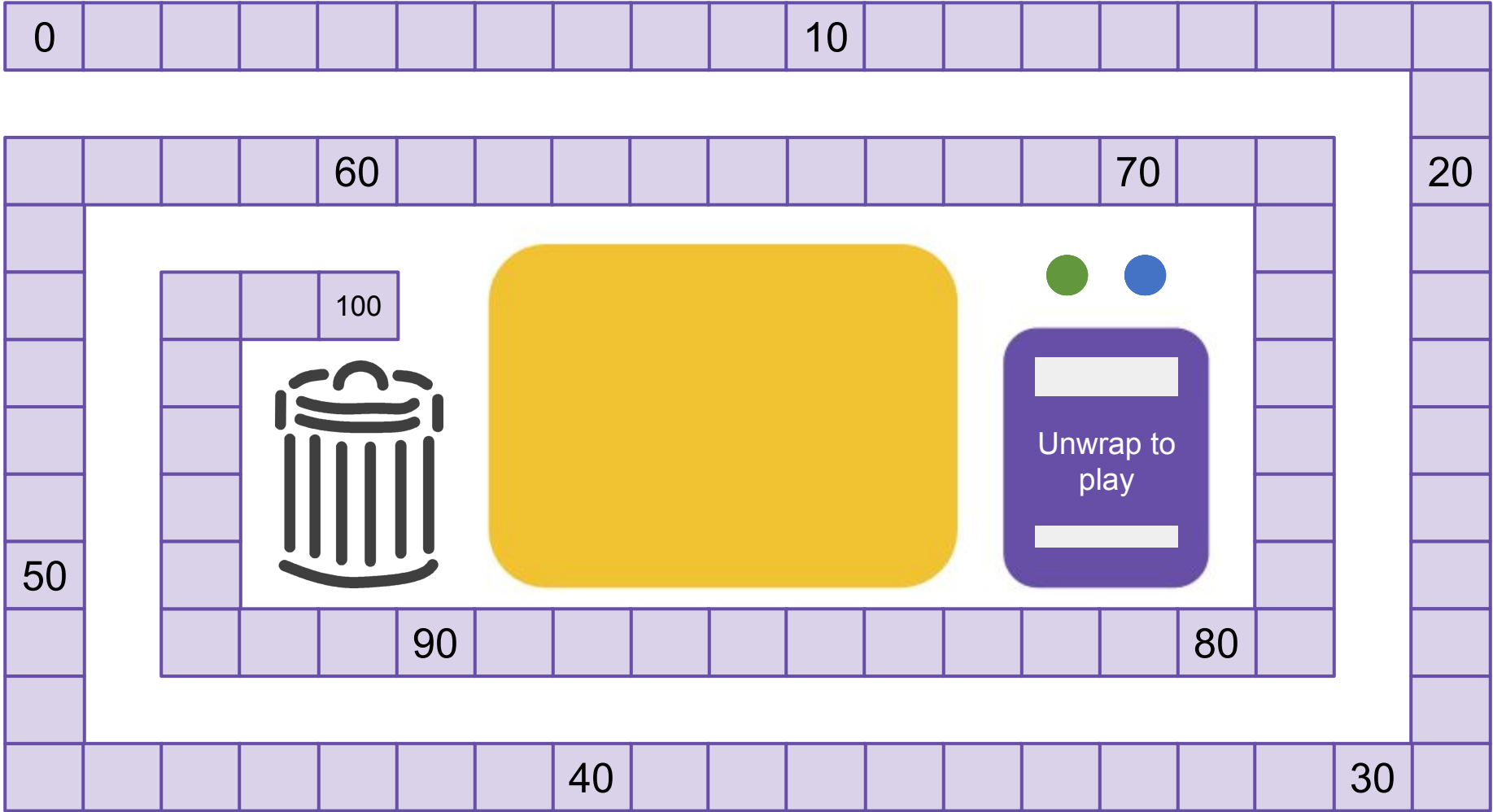


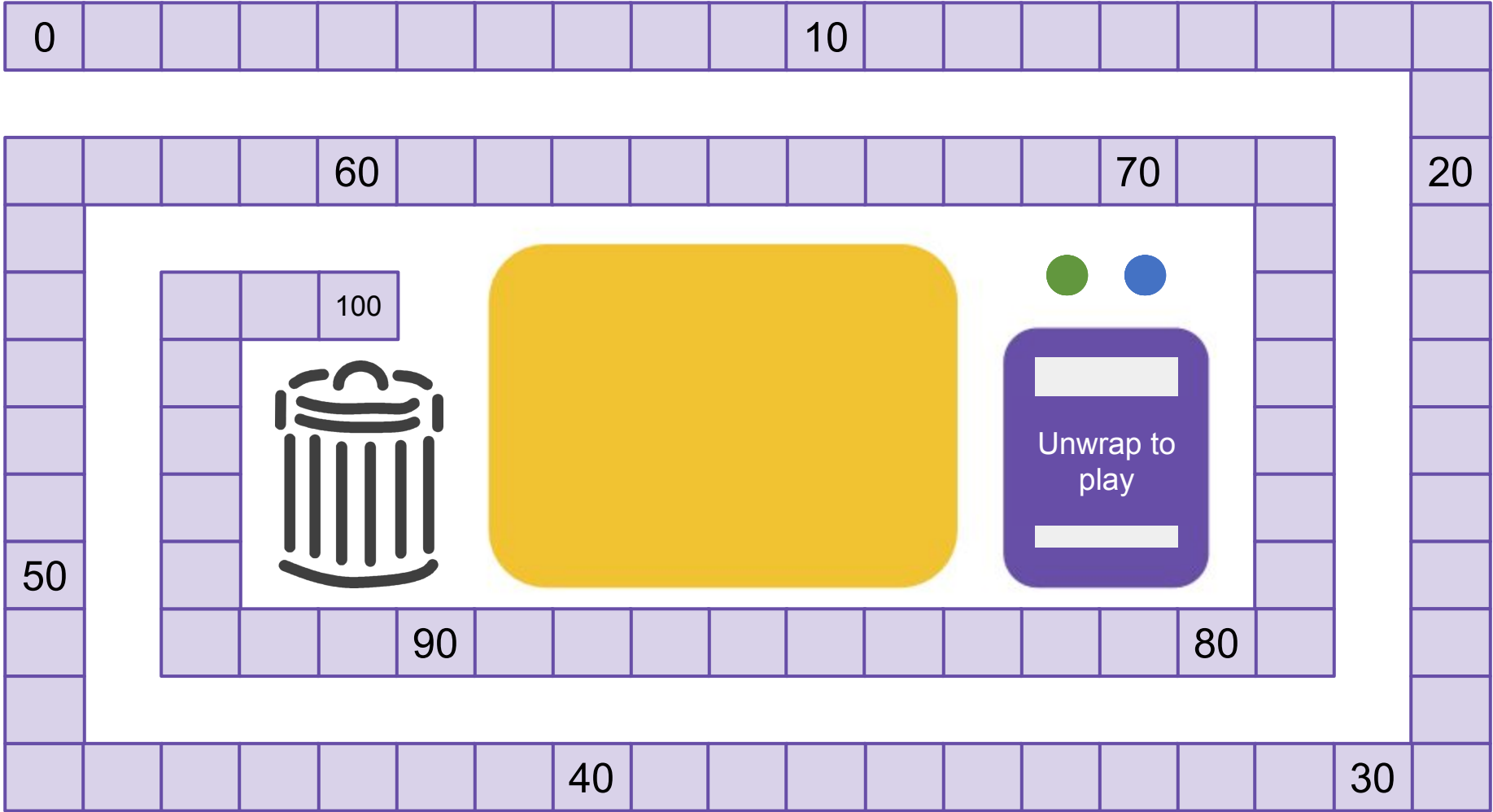


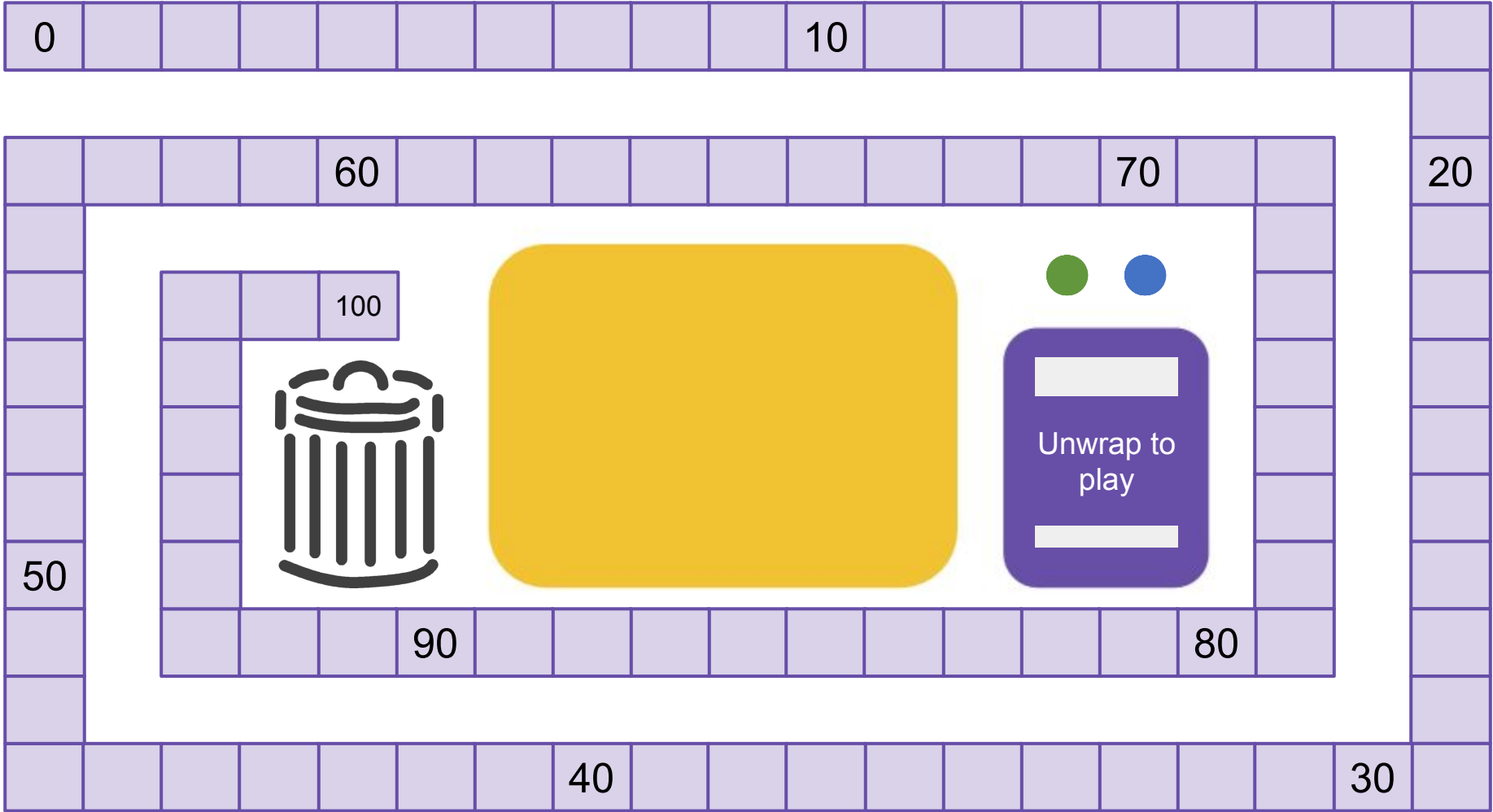


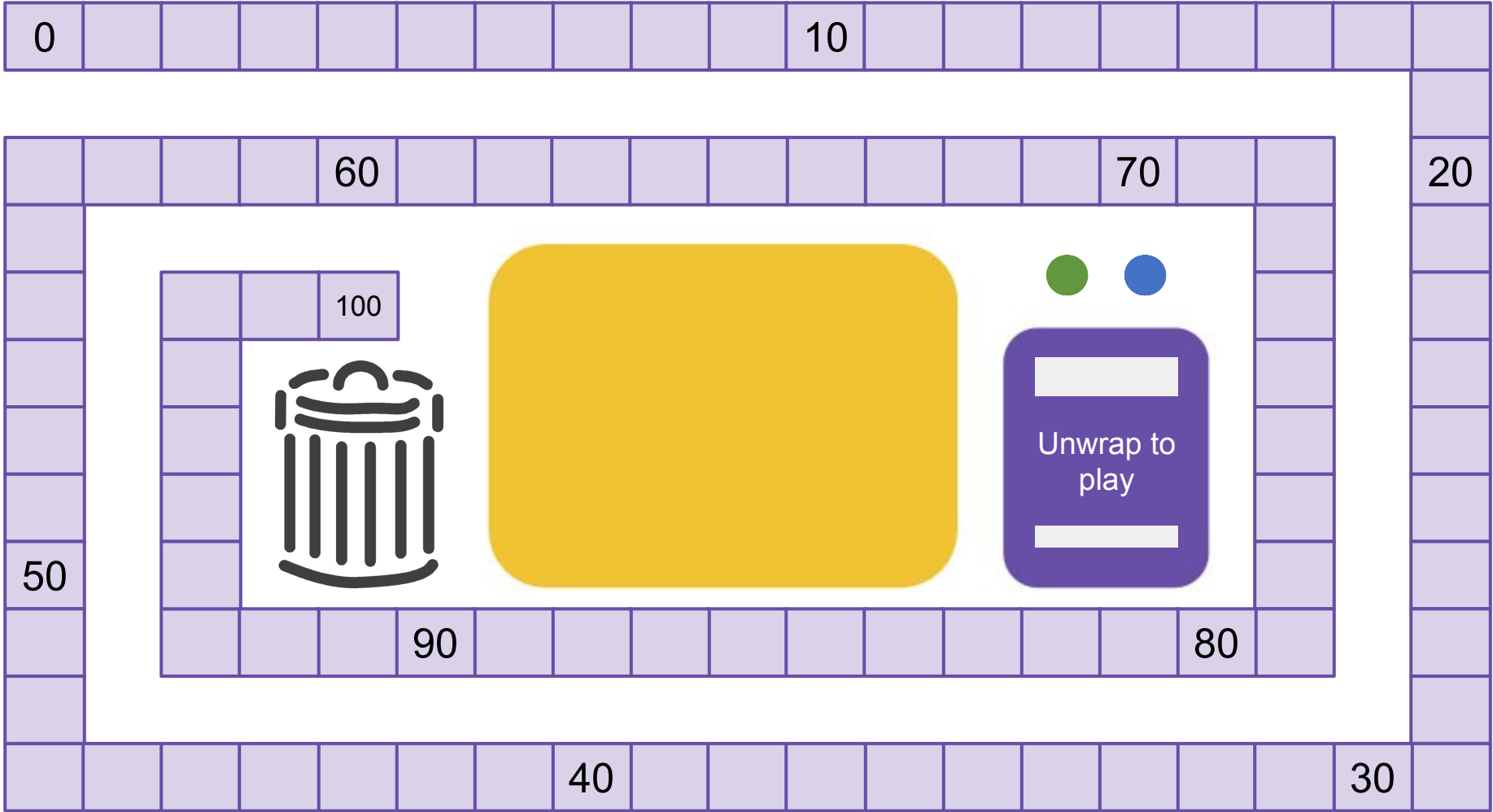


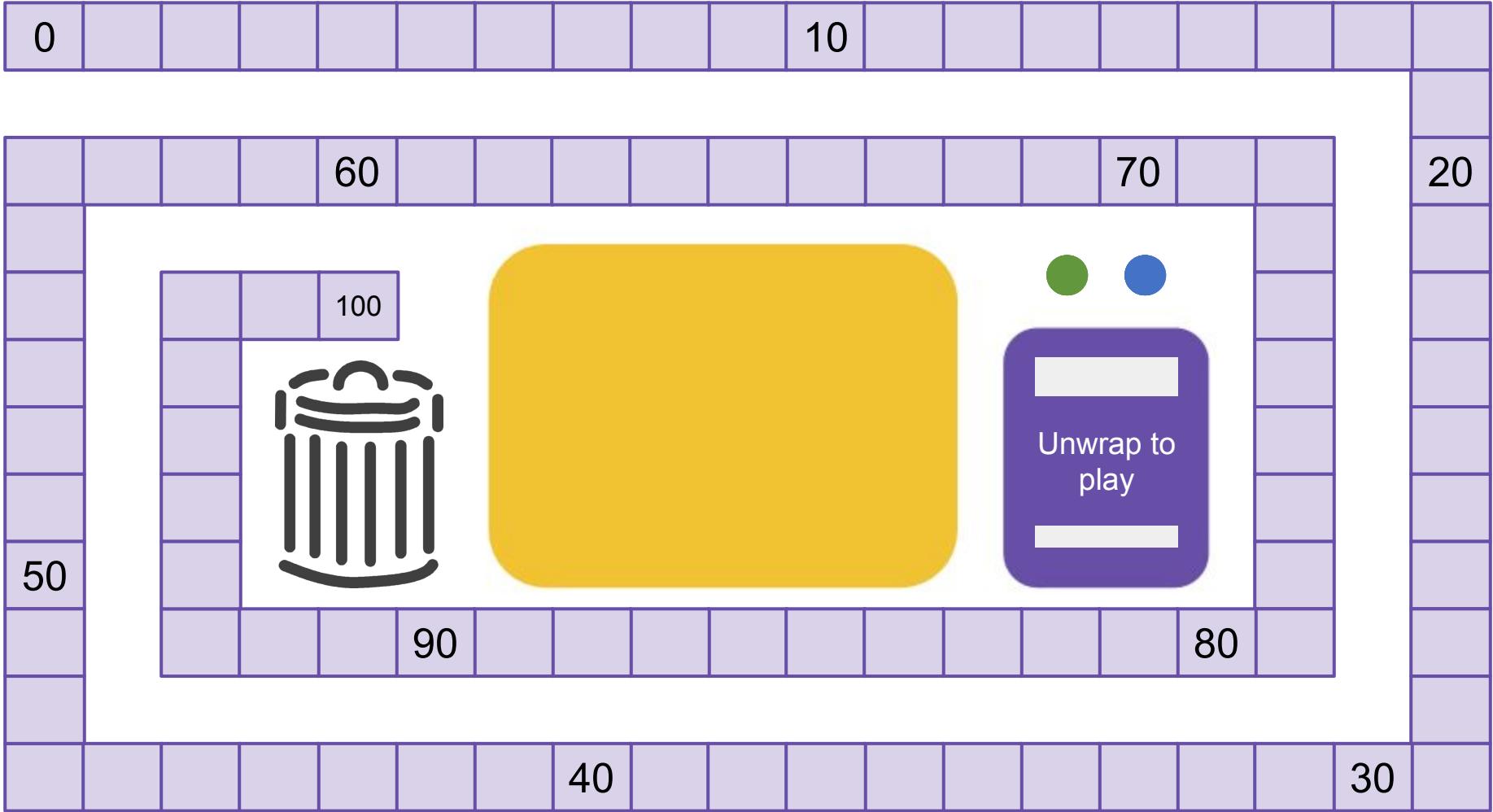




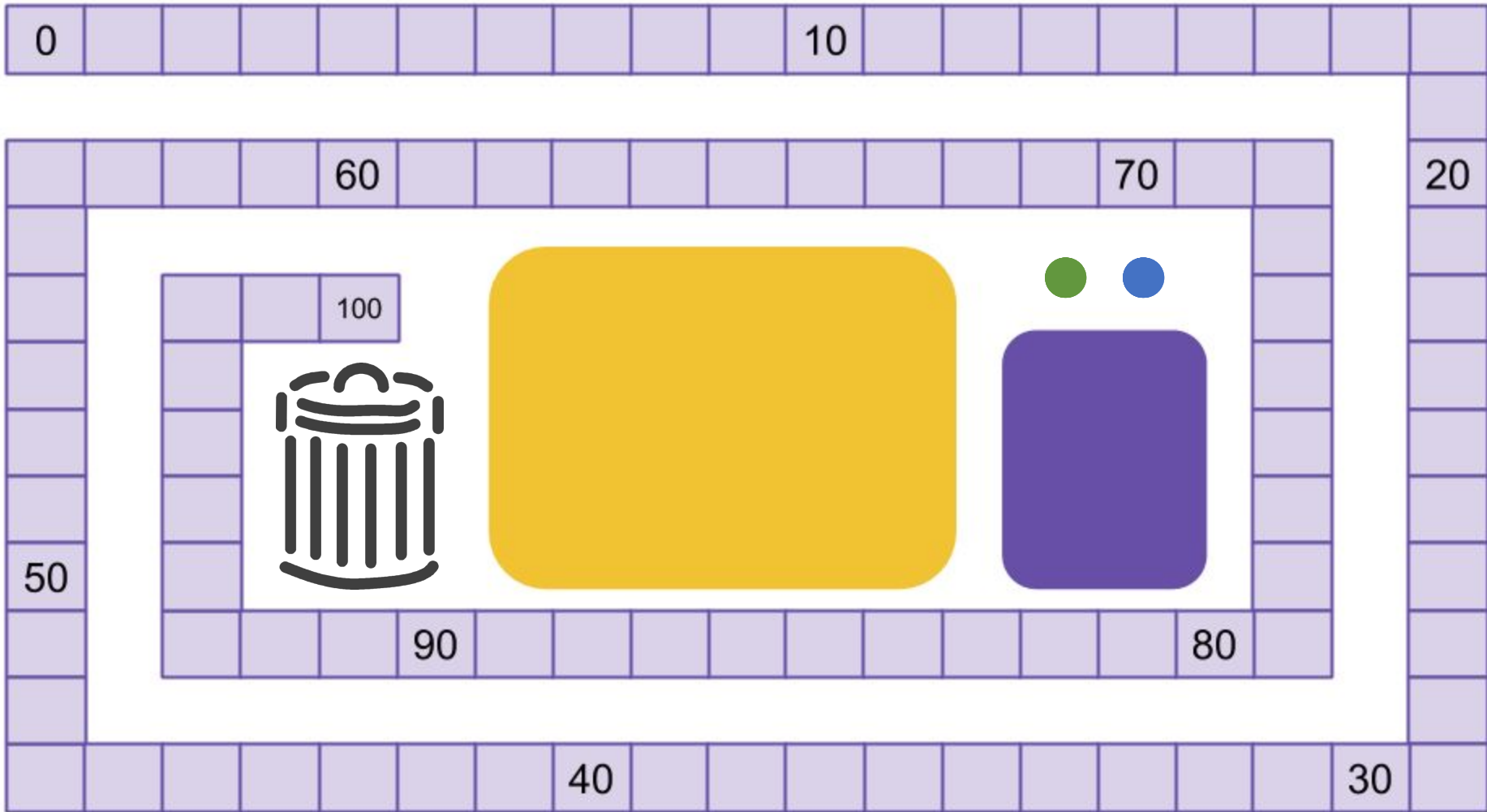
