### What is Prezi?

Instead of slides, **Prezi** makes use of one large canvas that allows you to pan and zoom to various parts of the canvas and emphasize the ideas presented there.

- Use for student projects
  - Infographics
  - Compare/Contrast
  - Visual Resumes
- Use for Collaboration
  - Collaborate presentations with colleagues

### **ThingLink**

### What is ThingLink?

- ThingLink is a digital tool that provides users with the ability to turn any image into an interactive graphic. You can create multiple "hot spots" on specific parts of an image and turn that image into a multimedia launcher.
- Include video, record audio or provide a link to any website with the click of a button. Easily embed an interactive ThingLink graphic into any blog or website.
