

### Class Aide Positions

- You must be approved by a teacher to be their class aide.
  - Email or ask in person.
- Not all teachers accept aides and many will get more requests than they have space for.
- Students can request to be a class aide for one semester or both.
- If you sign up for a class aide position and the teacher has not approved it, you will be placed in your second choice
- In some circumstances, we are unable to fulfill these requests due to schedule limitations. Even with teacher approval these positions are not guaranteed.
- Class aides may be asked to assist in the office one day a week.





### Office Aide Positions



- Office aides will be selected based on attendance and behavior.
  - An ideal candidate is a responsible and reliable student.
- Office aides will assist the office staff and counselors by delivering blue slips, making copies, and helping with special projects.
- These positions are limited, therefore we may be unable to fulfill all requests.
- Students can request to be an office aide for one semester or both.

- You do not have to take English 8 Advanced to sign up for Honors English in high school.
