# Network Zone: What is it?

## General

- Centrally-managed resources in an Alma collaborative network

## UC-SILS

- Shared bibliographic and authority records for all 10 UC campuses
  - Provides basic information about institutional holdings and items
- Electronic collections, titles and portfolios for CDL-managed resources, including Marcive records

  - Look-up or search: Keyword, Title, Creator, ISBN, ISSN or other fields that are part of the indexes above
  - Search zone: Network
  - Look at number of results
  - Locate Network Zone tab
  - Review Held by and Electronic details
