

Hide Option - Quota Overlimit



| Why?

Problem

With our current quota control jump to options, we can only setup branching options. However, even after quota is filled/achieved for an option, it is still displayed on the survey. We need the ability to hide an option once quota is reached for said option.

User Story

Tim is a researcher and is conducting research on various breakfast cereal types. Tim needs to acquire paid audience in different markets for his research. Tim has quotas for each market as well as cereal type. Currently, Tim has no ability to hide options for cereal type once quota is met. It increases his costs as well as distracts from the goals he has.

Quota Control

Once quota is met, we can currently jump to a question in the survey or terminate response by branching.


