Tips for Success...

- 1. **Don't read from your slide.** Your audience can read it just fine. Keep your bullet points basic. If you feel that you need to read what you're going to say, put it in the "speaker notes" below your slide or on a note card. The fewer words on your slide, the better.
- 2. **Don't use words that you don't know.** It makes you look like you don't know what you're talking about. Presenters who just copy and paste text often run into this problem.
- 3. **Don't skip the secret ingredient.** It represents a connection to *Lord of the Flies*.
- Give your audience something to see. Make the visual image(s) the focus of your slide, not any words you add.
- 5. **Review the PVLEGS chart** on the northeast wall to remember what an effective speaker does.
- 6. **Take about 30 seconds to discuss your slides.** Explain the information in a way that will make sense to your audience (14-15 year olds).


