





How can we help institutional leaders understand 1. How climate change will impact them and 2. How sustainability initiatives will benefit them?


Diversity, Equity, Inclusion - Shifts in Higher Education

As of 2016, more than two-thirds of major US universities had appointed a chief diversity officer or executive-level equivalent, with at least 30 institutions having created the role in the last five years alone. Pihakis, J. Paikeday, T. Armstrong, K and Meneer, E (2019).
