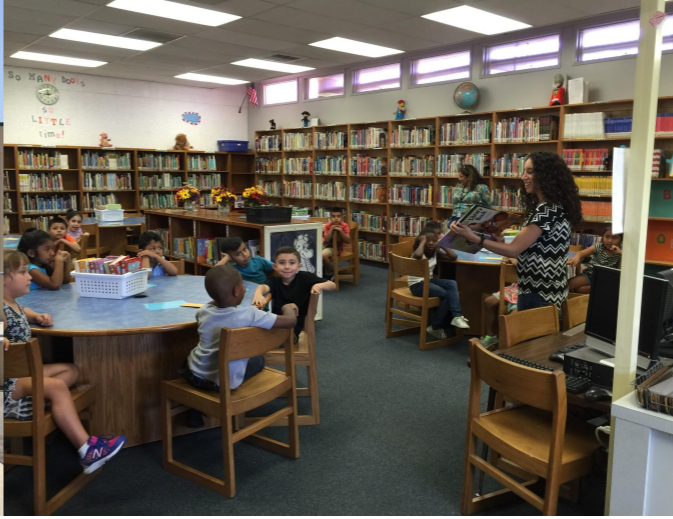

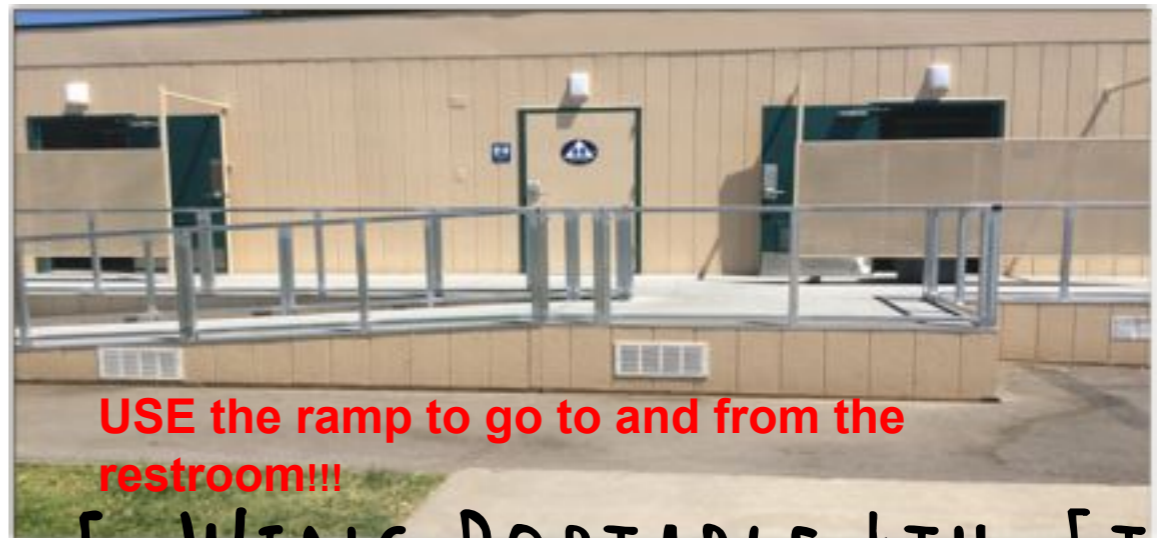

## \*\*\* BIG 3 DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS:

- 1) CLOTHING MUST COVER/CONCEAL UNDERGARMENTS
- 2) CLOTHING MUST COVER/CONCEAL PRIVATE PARTS
- 3) CLOTHING, BACKPACKS, AND ACCESSORIES MUST BE FREE OF IMAGES OR CONTENT THAT DISPLAYS/PROMOTES SEX, DRUGS, ALCOHOL OR TOBACCO USE, FIREARMS, OR GANG RELATED IMAGES.

# DRESS CODE

## **BIG THREE** EXPECTATIONS

- 1.** Clothing must cover and conceal undergarments; no private parts, including midriff, should be visible.
- 2.** Appropriate shoes must be worn at all times.
- 3.** Clothing, backpacks, and accessories must be free of images and content that are sexually suggestive, depict drugs, alcohol, or tobacco use, firearms, gang-related images, or other illegal activities.

RUSD believes that high student expectations and a safe and engaging learning environment prepares students for academic success and their future. All RUSD staff will support students by reinforcing Dress Code Policy 5132. Students who do not comply with the above dress code expectations, may be subject to progressive discipline.

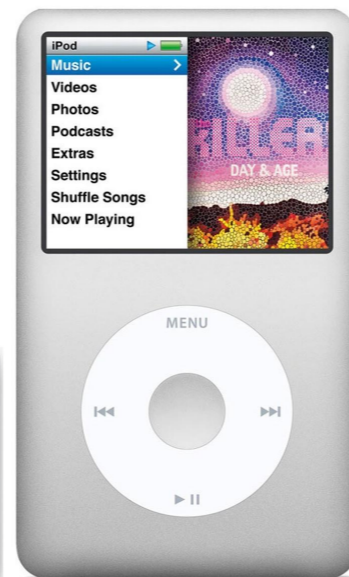
Any student in need of appropriate clothing, will be referred to the RUSD Kindness Connection.

## **MOBILE COMMUNICATION DEVICE POLICY**


### **ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

-  Students may use a device before school begins and after the school day ends.

-  Students need permission from a teacher or administrator to use the device during instructional time.

-  Students who choose not to honor the device policy will have consequences.

# ED CODE:

**Rialto Unified School District Bullying (Cyber bullying) Prevention** *Ed. Code 48900(a), (k), (o), (r), (s)*

The **Rialto Unified School District** believes that all students have a right to a safe and healthy school environment. The district, schools, and community have an obligation to promote mutual respect, tolerance, and acceptance.

**“Cyberbullying,”** sometimes referred to as internet bullying or electronic bullying, is defined as the “willful and repeated harm inflicted through the medium of electronic text”. It may involve:

- Sending mean, vulgar or threatening messages or images;
- Posting sensitive, private information about another person;
- Pretending to be someone else in order to make that person look bad; and
- Intentionally excluding someone from an online group.

***A student may be suspended from school for the following violations: 48900 (a)1***

Caused, attempted to cause or threatened to cause physical injury to another person; **(a)2** Willfully used force or violence upon the person of another, except in self-defense; **(b)** Possessed, sold, or otherwise furnished any firearm, knife, explosive, or other dangerous object; **(e)** Committed or attempted robbery or extortion; **(f)** Caused or attempted to cause damage to school property or private property; **(g)** Stole or attempted to steal school/private property; **(i)** ***Committed an obscene act or engaged in habitual profanity or vulgarity;*** **(k)** Disrupted school activities or otherwise willfully defied the valid authority of supervisors, teachers, administrators, school officials, or other school personnel; **(l)** Knowingly received stolen school or private property; **(m)** Possession of an imitation firearm; **(o)** Harassed, threatened, or intimidated a pupil who is a complaining witness or witness in a school disciplinary proceeding; **(q)** Engaged in, or attempted to engage in, hazing as defined in Section 32050; **(r)** Engaged in an act of bullying, including, but not limited to, bullying committed by means of an electronic act, as defined in subdivisions (f) and (g) of Section 32261, directed specifically toward a pupil or school personnel; **(s)** Aid or abet the infliction or attempted infliction of physical injury.

# BE KIND

  - a) help them out
  - b) go get an adult
- If you accidentally hit or trip someone;
  - a) see if they are ok
  - b) make sure to say I'm sorry
- Use KIND words
  - a) no spreading rumors or gossip
  - b) no bad words or name calling
