

We have students from throughout the district, though most students that apply live in Northeast and Southeast Portland.


- 33 % of our students self-identify as a student of color

## Schedule Breakdown

#### **Electives:**

#### **Exploratory Wheel:**

## Middle School Class Configuration

- → Blended 6th-8th Classes
  - ◆ Science, ELA and Electives
- → Grade Leveled Classes
  - Math and Compacted Math
  - ◆ Health/Dance Term
  - Social Studies
- → Teachers loop with students in Science, Language Arts and 7th/8th grade Social Science
