Remix


 Combine the original or revised content with other OER to create something new

# NYS OER Funding = \$8 Million

- \$4 Million to SUNY
- High Enrollment, General Education Courses

Baseline funding	Individual sections	All sections of a course
\$20,000	\$8 per student enrollment	\$15 per student

### \$4 Million to SUNY OER

- SUNY covers enrollments for initial sections in year 1
- Campuses develop a model to sustain OER adoption/creation (care & feeding of the puppies)
- Classes run for 3 years to ensure enrollments increase & research can be conducted
- This funding is the most any state has given to General Education OER to date

## **Thinking Beyond Textbooks**

- Organize OER making it discoverable (Librarians + metadata standard = MAGIC
- Digital Humanities = OER (can we wrap metadata around digital assets)
- Student undergraduate research as OER
- UFS Open Access Resolution

## **Benefits of OER?**

- Affordable for students
- Allows faculty to share materials they have found useful in their teaching
- Allows faculty to customize materials for course outcomes and specific situations
- Enables adding accessibility features without violating copyright laws

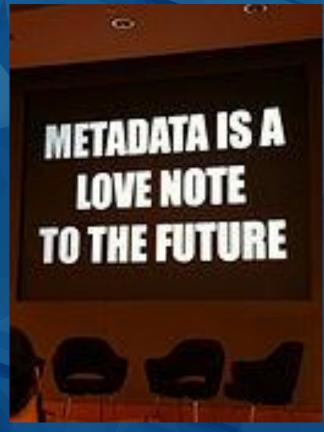
