






## DSpace Governance

## Why DSpace 7




01	Single User Interface (built on Angular.io)	•	Enhanced User Privacy (GDPR alignment)		
02	Fully-featured, integration-ready REST API		03	Support for OpenAIRE v4	
04	Configurable Entities (Person, Project, Publication, etc)		05	Can upgrade from any prior release of DSpace (after installing the new UI)	
06	Aligning with COAR Next Generation Repositories		Coming soon: Signposting, ResourceSync, Notify Project implementation		
07	Backwards compatible with existing integrations	•	Still includes OAI-PMH, SWORD (v1/v2), old REST API (v6), etc

## DSpace 7 Development per Year




#### **Lines of Code Changed per Major Release**

#### •7.0 (Aug 2021)

- New User Interface (redesigned search, deposit & admin tools)
- New REST API (all data/features available for integrations)
- OpenAIRE v4 support
- Configurable Entities (Person, Project, Publication, etc)

#### •7.1 (Nov 2021)

• IIIF Support, Request a Copy, Item Versioning, OAI Harvesting

#### •7.2 (Feb 2022)

• Runtime configs for User Interface, Item embargoes, Feedback form, OpenID Connect Auth

#### •7.3 (by June 27, 2022) (tentative feature list)


- Importing data from 10+ new sources (CrossRef, Scopus, etc)
- Admin Control Panel
- Deposit: Sherpa/Romeo & type based submission
- ORCID authentication & syncing with a Person Profile

#### •7.4 (Oct 2022) (features to be decided from priority ranking)

## DSpace 7.3 (tentative) Features



- ORCID authentication & sync to Researcher Profile
  - Login via ORCID, and easily create (or claim) a Researcher Profile page in DSpace.
  - Optionally sync that Profile with your ORCID account.
- Admin Control panel
  - "Health" reports which let you know if any parts of DSpace are not functioning properly
- Import content from any of the following systems
  - CrossRef, Scopus, CiNii, NASA Astrophysics Data System (ADS), Web of Science, VuFind.org,
     PubMed Europe, SciELO.org, European Patent Office (EPO)
- Features migrated from 6.x (all new to 7.x)
  - Preview / Validate Batch Metadata CSV changes during upload
  - Submission forms support display of SHERPA/RoMEO publisher policies when an ISSN is entered.
  - Submission forms support type-based fields. Based on selected "Type" (dc.type), the form may dynamically add/change metadata fields.
  - Preview items during workflow approval
  - RSS / Atom feeds for Site, Community, Collection
  - Withdrawn Item tombstone page
- Configurable Entities support Versioning
- Performance improvements : initial page load is much quicker!
- And a lot of bug fixes...





DSpace is the world leading open source repository platform that enables organisations to:

- · easily ingest documents, audio, video, datasets and their corresponding Dublin Core metadata
- · open up this content to local and global audiences, thanks to the OAI-PMH interface and Google Scholar optimizations
- issue permanent urls and trustworthy identifiers, including optional integrations with handle.net and DataCite DOI



## DSpace 5 & 6 "end of life" in 2023



DSpace 5.x support will end on Jan 1, 2023 DSpace 6.x support will end on July 1, 2023

#### Why?

- 5.x was released in 2015. 6.x was released in 2016.
- Both platforms have become difficult to support/maintain many underlying libraries are "end of life", and cannot be upgraded safely.
- Concerns that future security vulnerabilities may not be fixable.

We recommend all institutions upgrade to DSpace 7 as soon as possible.

Working Group's primary recommendations for DSpace's governance groups to consider:


- 1. Modularize the DSpace architecture

- 3. Explicitly conform to selected standards and international initiatives





