

 Students must have passed 3.5 credits the semester before involvement in sport/activity


• Students must be enrolled in 3.5 credits the semester of their involvement in sport/activity.

- Don't forget to request your transcript be sent to NCAA/NAIA

- Ask your school if ACT scores must be sent directly from ACT
- Be aware of scholarship deadlines when deciding when to take the ACT


# Applying for College

    - Must have one on file to send transcripts to colleges
  - Transcript/Records Request
