


The purpose of this data overview is to review demographic and student achievement data for Pepperell Middle School for the last 3 years using Milestones EOG and CRCT Results.







Demographics by year and percentage




Year 2 - Milestones EOG - White, Hispanic and Black

Year 3 - Milestones EOG - White, Hispanic and Black



Student Free and Reduced Lunch Percentages




Total Student Population

Strengths

- The percentage of Year 2 Hispanics outperformed all other ethnicities/races
- No substantial achievement gap between Hispanics and whites
- No substantial difference between test scores at Pepperell Middle School and the district scores

Weaknesses

- Achievement Gap between Black students and all other ethnicities/races
- Moving students from Proficient to Distinguished remains an obstacle for Pepperell Middle School and the system

Summary

- Pepperell Middle School is in line with the performance of the system.
- However, scores are a bell curve that leans left towards Beginning learner instead of toward the center.
- Pepperell Middle School and the system saw a dip in scores when the Milestones EOG was introduced, which was consistent across the state.
