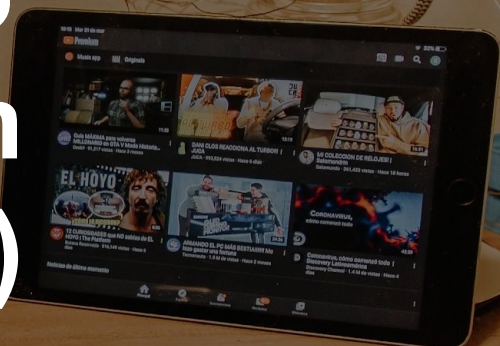

Be Engaged!

Turn on Your Video

Environment



- Face a light source
 - Light or window
 - Background light will darken your face
- Be aware of your background
 - Visual- use a virtual background if you share a space
 - Noise - mute your microphone
- Consider using headphones & a microphone

Be Engaged! Use the Attendee Controls

- Use the Reactions Tools
 - Raise your Hand
 - Clap
 - Ask to slow things down
- Ask questions in Chat
 - If you know the answer, respond to others in Chat
