


Xiamen's Cityscape

China's Imports



福建省福州市马尾区人民法院 刑事判决书

(2018) 闽0105刑初88号

公诉机关福州市马尾区人民检察院。

被告人康建灵，男，1990年05月02日出生，汉族，小学文化程度，无业，住福建省龙海市。因涉嫌犯非法采矿罪，于2018年4月18日被福建省公安边防总队海警第一支队取保候审。

福州市马尾区人民检察院以马检生态刑诉[2018]2号起诉书指控被告人康建灵犯非法采矿罪，于2018年6月4日向本院提起公诉。本院依法适用认罪认罚从宽制度，适用简易程序，实行独任审判，公开开庭审理了本案。福州市马尾区人民检察院指派检察员吴某、检某出庭支持公诉，被告人康建灵到庭参加诉讼。现已审理终结。

公诉机关指控：

2017年1月17日、4月18日、7月18日，作为“顺兴6686”船实际经营者被告人康建灵在未取得**海砂**开采海域使用权证和采矿许可证的情况下，先后3次通过电话指挥“顺兴6686”船船长姚某1（另案处理）前往七星礁东南面附近海域(26°03.500'N，119°51.500'E)、目屿岛西面附近海域(26°19.210'N，119°52.817'E)、西犬岛西面海域(25°59.612'N，119°50.561'E)进行无证采挖**海砂**作业，3次非法采砂行为均被中国渔政执法人员当场查获。后康建灵分别于2017年1月22日、4月25日、7月25日先后三次被福州市海洋渔业局各处处以罚款10万元人民币的行政处罚，并被责令将其所采的**海砂**卸回采砂海域。


2018年3月28日，被告人康建灵非法采矿案件被福州市海洋渔业局移送至福建省立案侦查。2018年4月18日，被告人康建灵主动到福建省投案。
