How to Register:

Registration:

Complete the Summer Programming Registration Form that is linked on slide 16.

- Only one registration form is needed per family.
- Registration is done by the week rather than by the camp.

Priority Deadline:

March 15, 2024* in order to be entered into the lottery.

Acceptance:

Acceptance or notification of placement on the waitlist will be sent to families no later than **April 5**, **2024**.

*Applications to camps/programs will still be accepted after the registration deadline <u>IF</u> there is capacity in the program to accept more students.

Lottery System:

All camps have a certain number of students they can serve. Spots will be filled using a lottery process.

Lottery Process:

- First priority to applications received by March 15th
- Second round will be for applications received after March 15th
- Siblings will be entered into the lottery together.

Please Note:

• Only register for camps you know your child is available to attend.

• You do not need to sign up for every week of camp.

• If you register for a camp and are unable to attend, please email the camp director as well as <u>summerfun@gisu.org</u> so that the spot can be offered to another student.

- This is a club for students interested in learning skills to thrive in the woods, as well as deepen their connection with the natural world. Based at the South Hero Recreation Park, we will also spend time in the Folsom Learning Garden, as well as nearby conserved natural areas.
- In giving credit to the Abenaki and other Indigenous cultures, we will explore the differences between appreciation vs appropriation, as well as the importance of honoring tribal sovereignty. Through a progression of hands-on activities, we will cover shelter building, firemaking, cooking, edible and poisonous plants ID, bird languages, fishing, ethical wildcrafting, tracking, using natural materials to make ropes, tools & art, and more. With an ethos of safety and reciprocity, this camp will give students the knowledge to enjoy the outdoors, be good stewards of the land, as well as gain a better appreciation for the peoples who have maintained these traditional ecological skills since time immemorial.


Let's Cook! - Grand Isle School
