

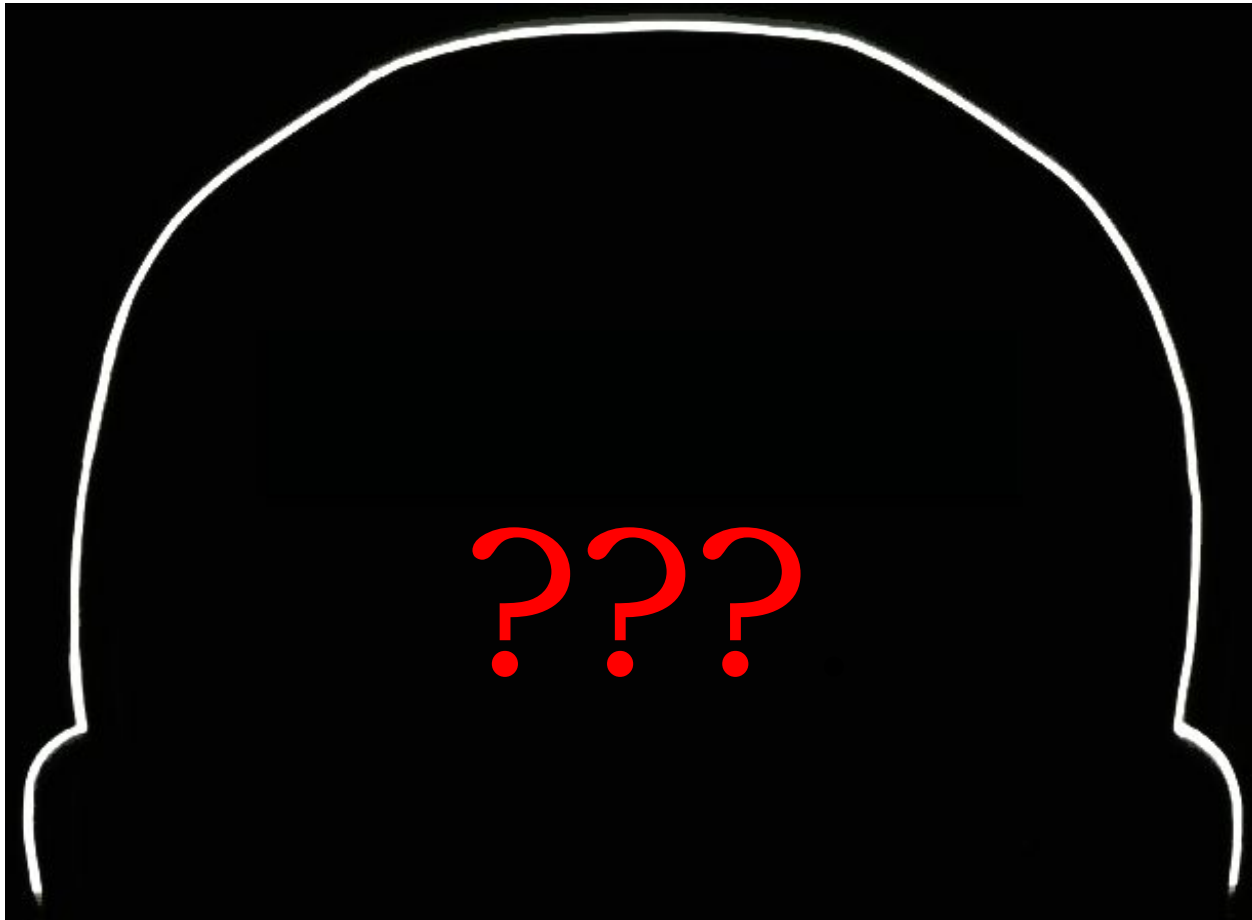

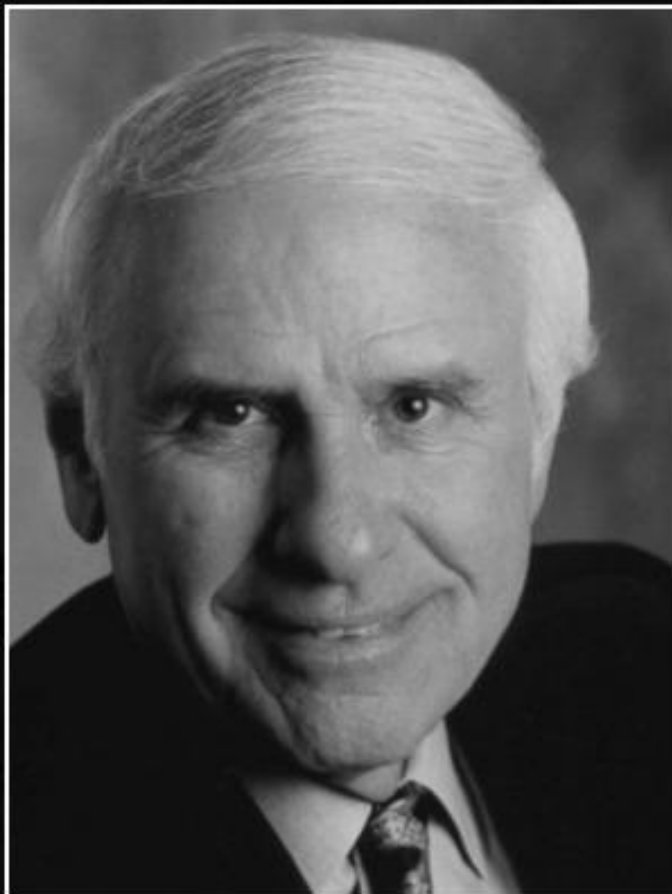

- Talk over the issues you wish you would have known about adulthood
- Allow them to attempt things that stretch them or even let them fail
- Discuss the future consequences if they fail to master certain disciplines
- Aid them in matching their strengths to real world problem
- Furnish project that require patience, so that they learn to delay gratification
- Teach them that life is about choices and trade offs; they cant do everything
- Initiate (or simulate) adult tasks like paying bills or making business deals
- Introduce them to potential mentors from your network
- Help them envision a fulfilling future and then discuss the steps to get there
- Celebrate progress they make towards autonomy & responsibility

- Be a good role model in all you say & do
- Communicate respectfully and listen attentively to your child
- Discipline fairly, firmly and with love
- Encourage good eating habits
- Find ways to get and stay fit together
- Give chores that built responsibility
- Hug your child to build self worth
- Instill respect for other people
- Join forums to assess child's progress including PTM meet
- Keep your promise or do not make them
- Laugh together & enjoy each other's company
- Make family rules, enforce them consistently

A2Z of Parenting

- Never use physical force on your child
- Offer your help whenever it's needed
- Praise your child for achievement as well as for efforts
- Quickly stop your child from harmful activities
- Read together often and make reading fun
- Show patience & remember nobody is perfect
