Your animation or game should include the following elements :

Your program should include the following elements :

| <input type="checkbox"/> | at least one programming loop |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | Make sure your animation does not exceed a maximum of 4 minutes. |



Elements related to publication

To publish your project, you should:

<input type="checkbox"/>	have a meaningful title followed by Kreocode 20XX (e.g.: I recycle - Kreocode 20XX)
<input type="checkbox"/>	use images, photos or sounds that are copyright free (do not use photos of personal information of students)
<input type="checkbox"/>	cite any sources used in the space reserved for <i>Notes and Credits</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>	pay close attention to your use of language
<input type="checkbox"/>	indicate how to start your program in the <i>Instructions</i> section (if it does not start with the green flag)
<input type="checkbox"/>	shart the project (* once your project is complete)
