





Creating Student Interest Surveys

- Choose a Platform: Utilize online survey tools like Google Forms or Microsoft Forms.
- **Design the Survey:** Start with a template or a blank form. Add a title and description to your survey.
- Formulate Questions: Include a mix of question types (multiple choice, short answer, etc.). Consider using statements with a five-point Likert scale for responses.
- Customize Appearance: Personalize the survey with colors, fonts, and images to make it visually appealing.
- Distribute the Survey: Share the survey link with students via email or platforms like Google Classroom. Or print the survey and have students complete on paper. How to print a Google form.
- Analyze Responses: Review the responses to identify patterns and interests that can inform your teaching approach.








