## Student Teaching Pathway

- Clinical practice often occurs after coursework is completed
- 1 semester (or less) with mentor
- Typically completed at

## Intern Pathway

- Two years of coursework
- Paid as teacher of record

- One year of coursework tightly woven with clinical practice
- Entire year with mentor
- Become part of school/district's culture prior to employment
- Strong cohort model
- Extra adult in the classroom
- Support!!!
- Increasing grant \$ available

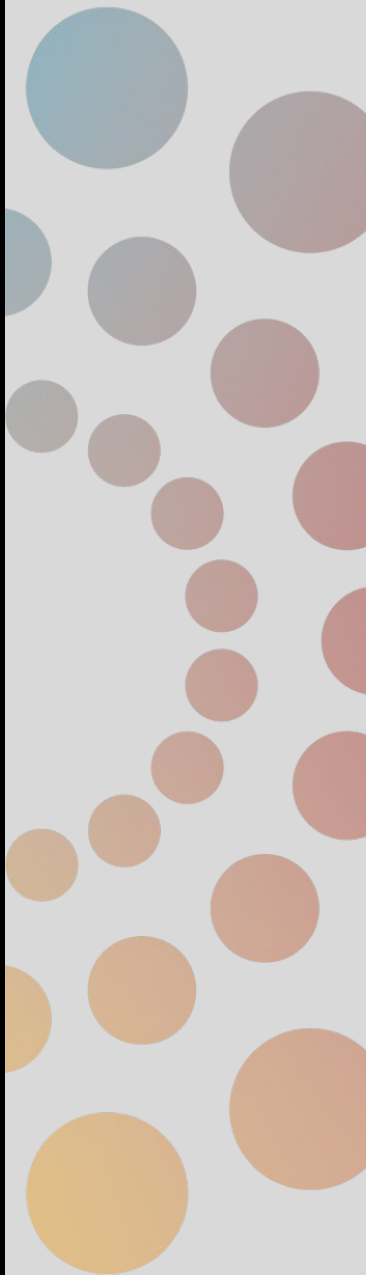



# Bachelor's Degree

(or higher)

If your bachelor's degree is not complete upon application submission, submit your official transcripts and a letter from your university verifying that you are on track to graduate prior to program

- Degree must be completed at a regionally accredited college
- Course work and degrees completed outside of the United States must be evaluated by a Commission-approved foreign transcript evaluation agency



## US Constitution Requirement

May be met ONE of the following ways:

- If you have a BA/BS from a California State University (CSU)
- A course covering the provisions and principles of the US Constitution
- An examination covering the provisions and principles of the US Constitution



# Basic Skills Requirement

May be met by ONE of the following ways:

- Passing CBEST score report
- Passing CSET Multiple Subject plus CSET Writing Skills examination score report
- Qualifying scores on the CSU Early Assessment Program or the CSU Placement Examinations
- Qualifying scores on the SAT or ACT
- Qualifying scores on the College Board Advanced Placement (AP) examination(s) report
- Passing Basic Skills examination score report from another state
- Evidence of completing the Basic Skills Requirement by coursework\*

# Subject Matter Competence\*

Candidates for a teaching credential must demonstrate they are proficient in the subject matter area of their intended credential.

May be met by ONE of the following ways:

- CSET exams
- Subject matter preparation program
- Coursework (Less than 5% fully meet the requirement through coursework.)\*

• **Exact degree match**  
\*Subject Matter Competence must be completed prior to Semester 2

\*Requires coursework evaluation



# Subject Matter Competence for Education Specialist Candidates

The major must be an exact degree/credential subject match in one of the subjects below:

- Liberal Studies degree
- Liberal Studies degrees that include any focus or concentration in the title. Examples include, but are not limited to, Liberal Studies: Urban Education and Liberal Studies: Elementary Education.
- Liberal Arts
- Elementary Education
- Agriculture
- Art
- Business
- English
- Dance
- Health Science
- Home Economics
- Industrial and Technology Education
- Mathematics
- Music
- Physical Education
- Science (including Biology, Chemistry, Geoscience or Earth and Space Science, and Physics)

# Application Requirements

After TCSJ application is submitted, you will receive an email with a link to the DUSD application



## TCSJ Application

- Copy of Photo Identification, e.g. Driver's License, Passport, Military ID
- Bachelor's degree (official transcripts)
  - If you are completing your bachelor's degree this spring, submit your official transcripts and a letter from your university verifying that you are on track to graduate.
- Certificate of Clearance
- US Constitution requirement
- Basic Skills Requirement
- Subject Matter Competency Verification (or proof of progress)
- \$65 non-refundable application fee

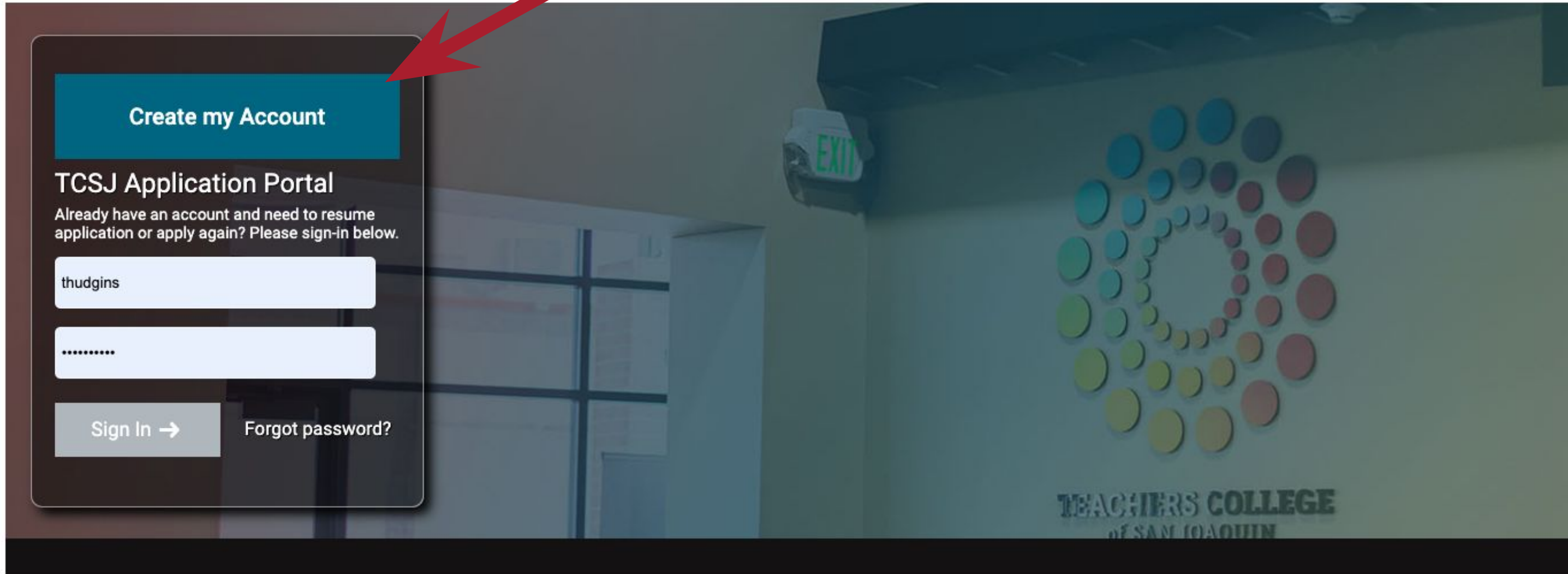

Before you create your application for admission, please review the available programs and the respective admission requirements. You will be asked for the following when creating your application:

**Enrollment Type:** Make your selection from the list provided (eg. undergraduate), based upon your review of the programs available through Teachers College. The programs available to apply to will be specific to the enrollment type that you select.

**Program:** Make your selection from the list provided. Your application will only be considered for the program selected. You will be unable to modify the program after creating the application. If you decide to change the program, it will require that you withdraw the application and create a new one.

**Degree:** If the program you selected offers more than one option, you will be asked to select your program type.

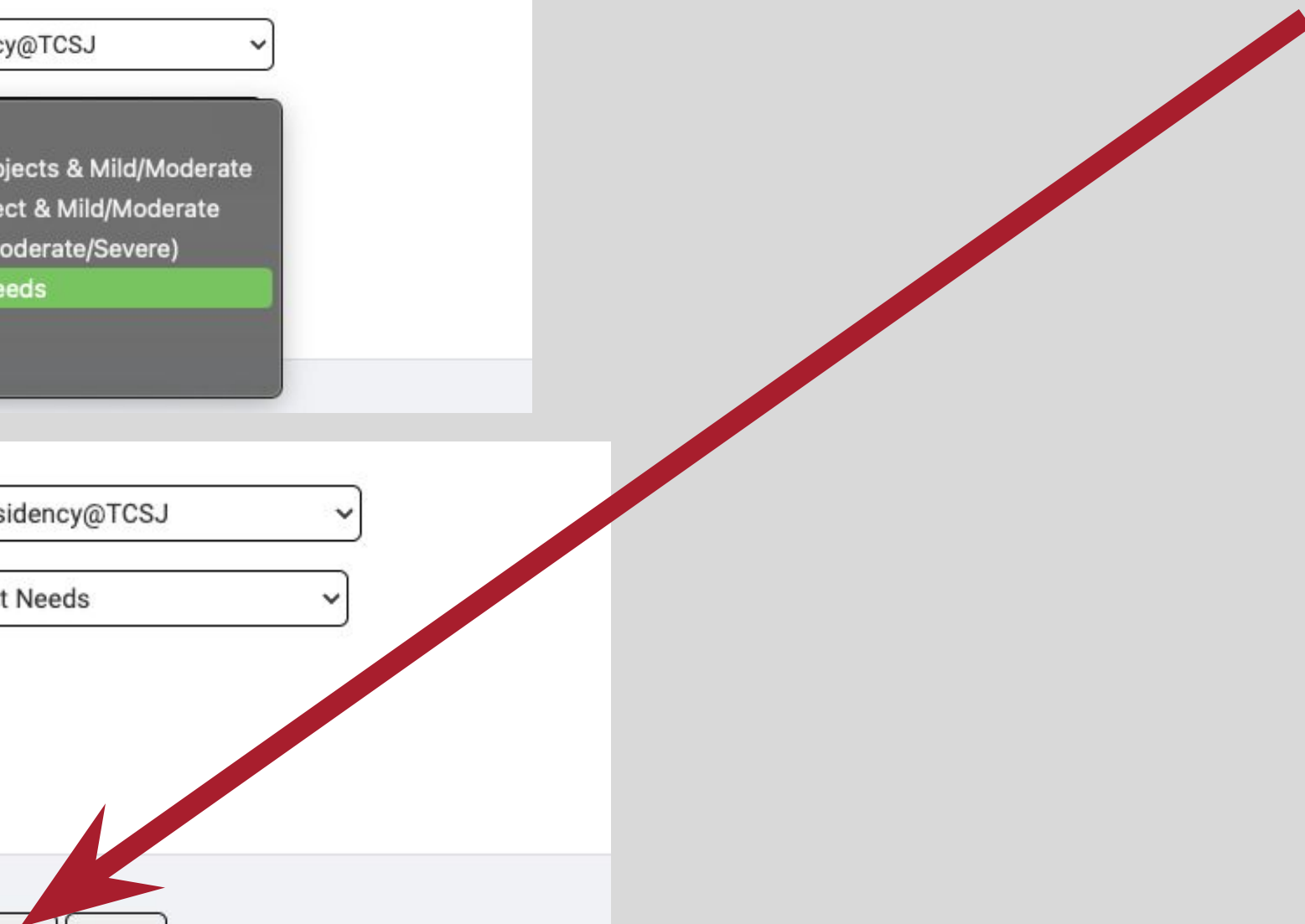

TCSJ /Denair Unified School District Committee will review applications and select the candidates who will move on to the

interview stage

Applicants selected for interviews will indicate their schools of

choice

Interviews will take place with schools of choice

If you are selected by a school, you will then be formally accepted



# Program Costs\*

## -Tuition (Program Cost + \$150 Tech Fee):

- Dual Credential - \$12,873
- Single Credential - \$11,702

## -Additional Fees:

- \$65 application fee
- \$400 enrollment deposit (goes toward tuition)
- \$135 coursework evaluation fee (basic skills and/or subject matter)
- CTC fees to process sub permit and preliminary teaching credential
- Assessment fees
