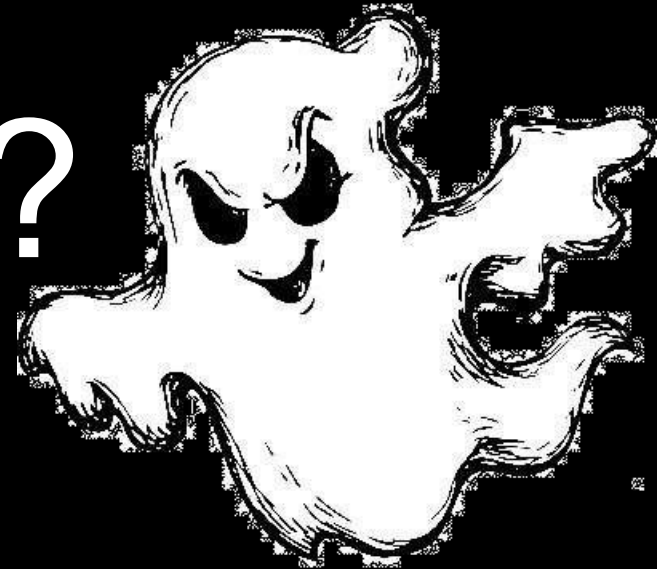

Why people believe?

WHERE GHOSTS EXIST?

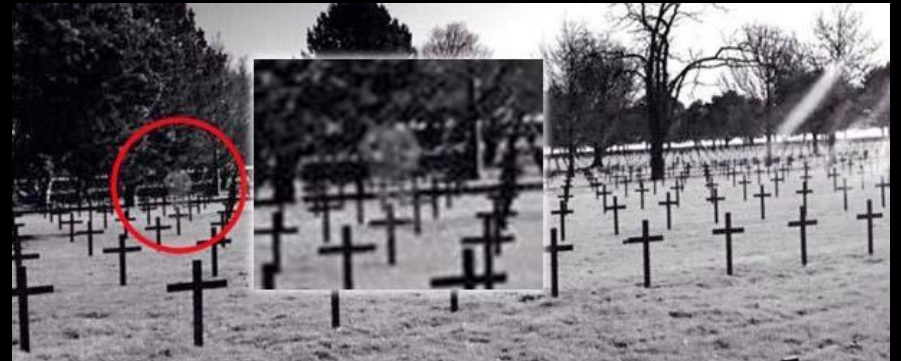
