A portal helps to teleport something from one to another place...



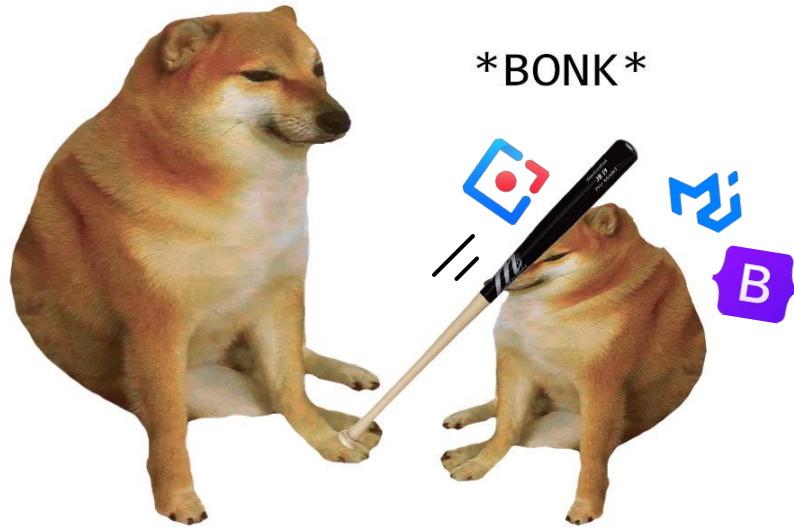
The thinking behind
this...

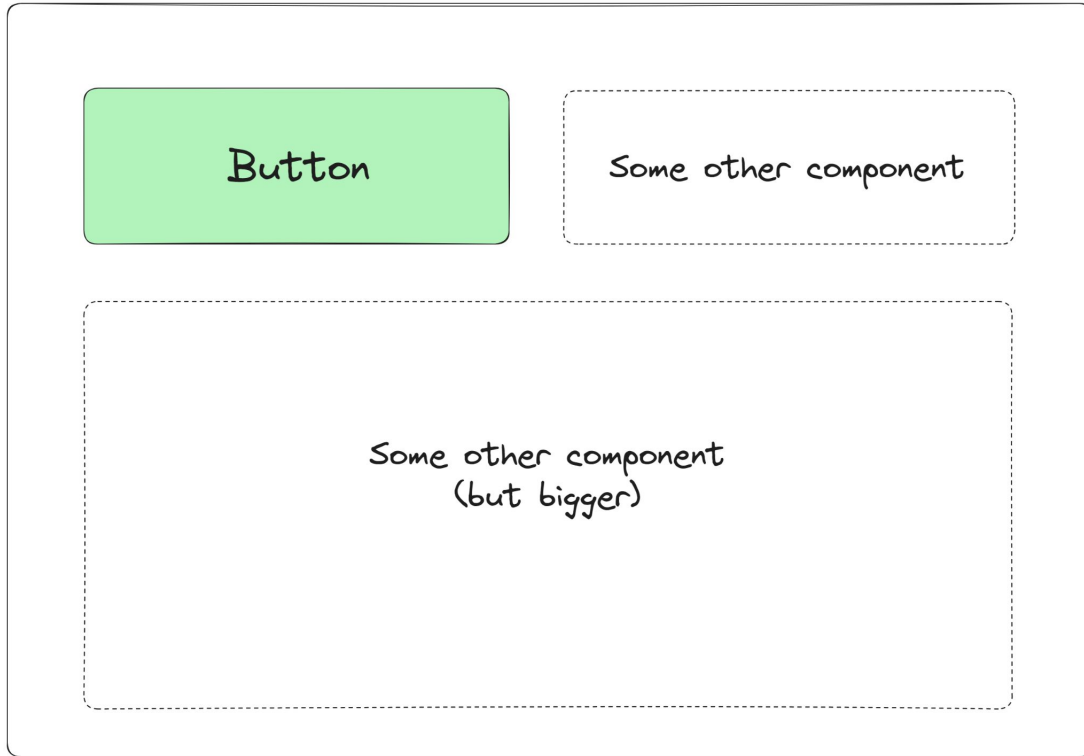
I asked AI...

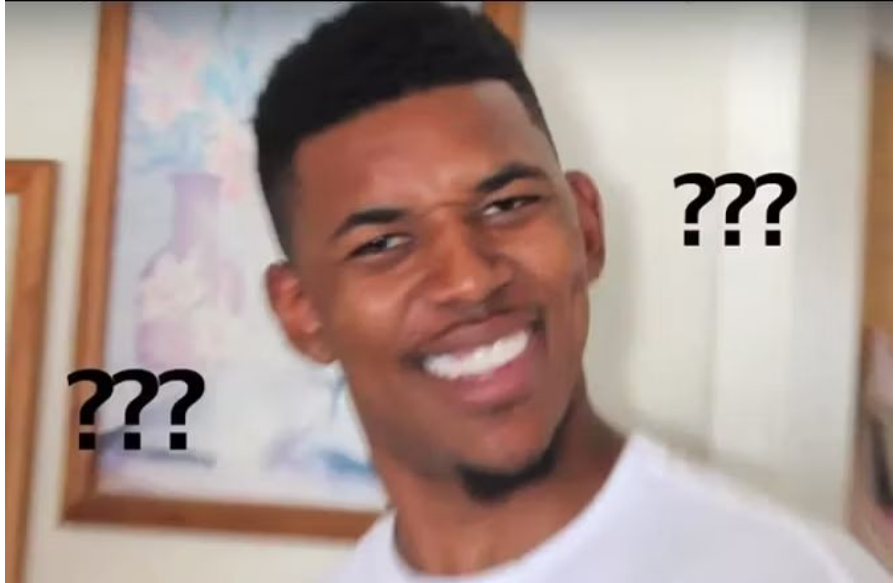
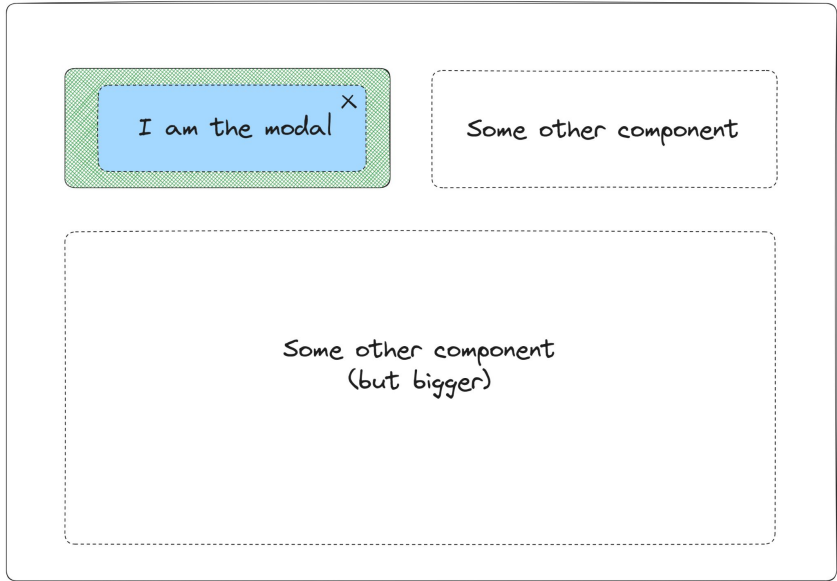
Now think of a modal!

for data is not the **best place**

solve this...

(Other than using z-index: 999999)

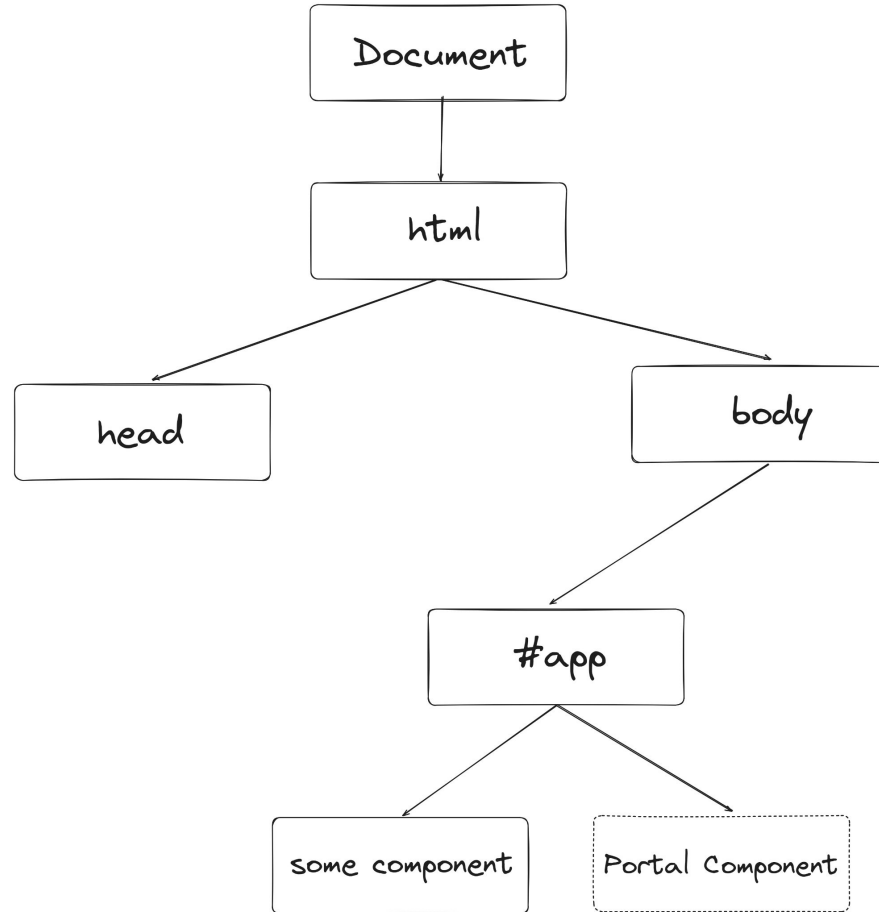
- Built in component in Vue
- Only updates the rendered DOM
- Does not affect the logical hierarchy of the components
- Has two props - to, disabled
- to: CSS Selector
- disabled: to disable in special cases

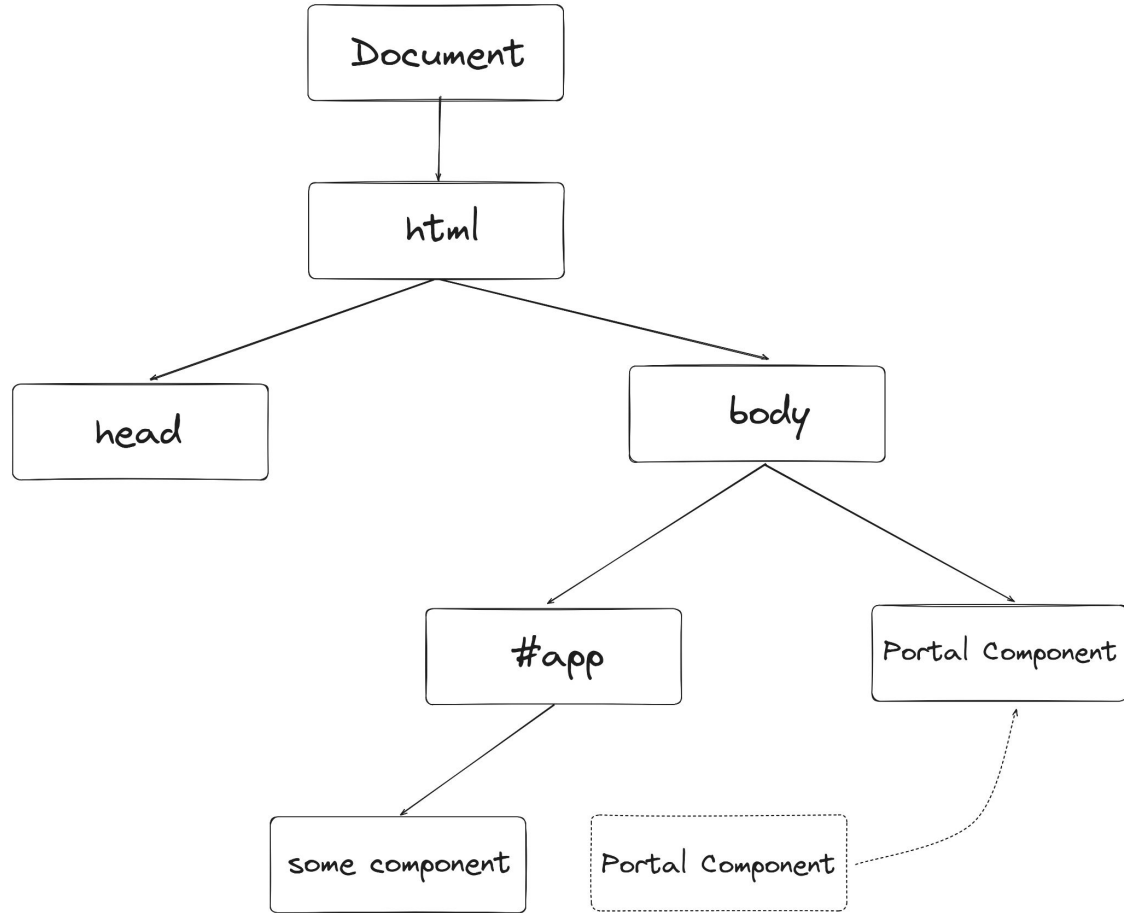

- Optimized Performance

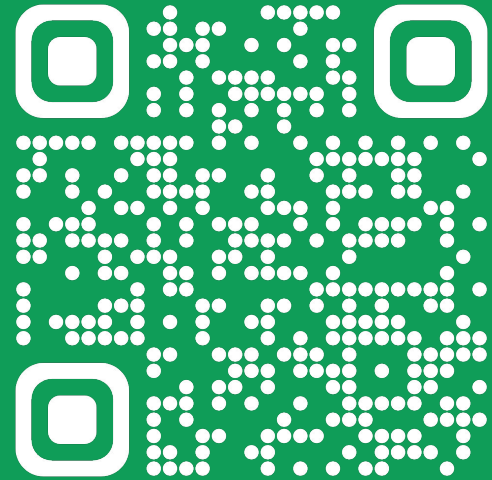
