# Open Education Resources are freely available, openly licensed resources.

What is copyright?

#### The right to own and protect one's intellectual property



# The ability to use copyrighted work within limits. Typically, small parts of works can be used under certain conditions.

## **Classroom Use Exception**

A copyrighted work can be displayed or performed in a face-to-face classroom in a school or non-profit educational institution.

- No copies can be made.
- This does not apply to online classes.

#### **Creative Commons Licenses**

- More open than fair use
- You can use, freely distribute, and sometimes remix a resource

#### What to add to your remix:

- Images, Powerpoint slides from an existing course, infographics, text/description, video, etc
- If not your content, make sure it is openly licensed.

- 2. Find or create the content that you want to add.
- 3. Hit the remix button on your resource and remix it.
- 4. Publish it!
