What is OER?

Open Education Resources are freely available, openly licensed resources.



What is copyright?

The right to own and protect one's intellectual property



What is fair use?

The ability to use copyrighted work within limits. Typically, small parts of works can be used under certain conditions.



Classroom Use Exception

A copyrighted work can be displayed or performed in a face-to-face classroom in a school or non-profit educational institution.

- No copies can be made.
- This does not apply to online classes.



Creative Commons Licenses

- More open than fair use
- You can use, freely distribute, and sometimes remix a resource
