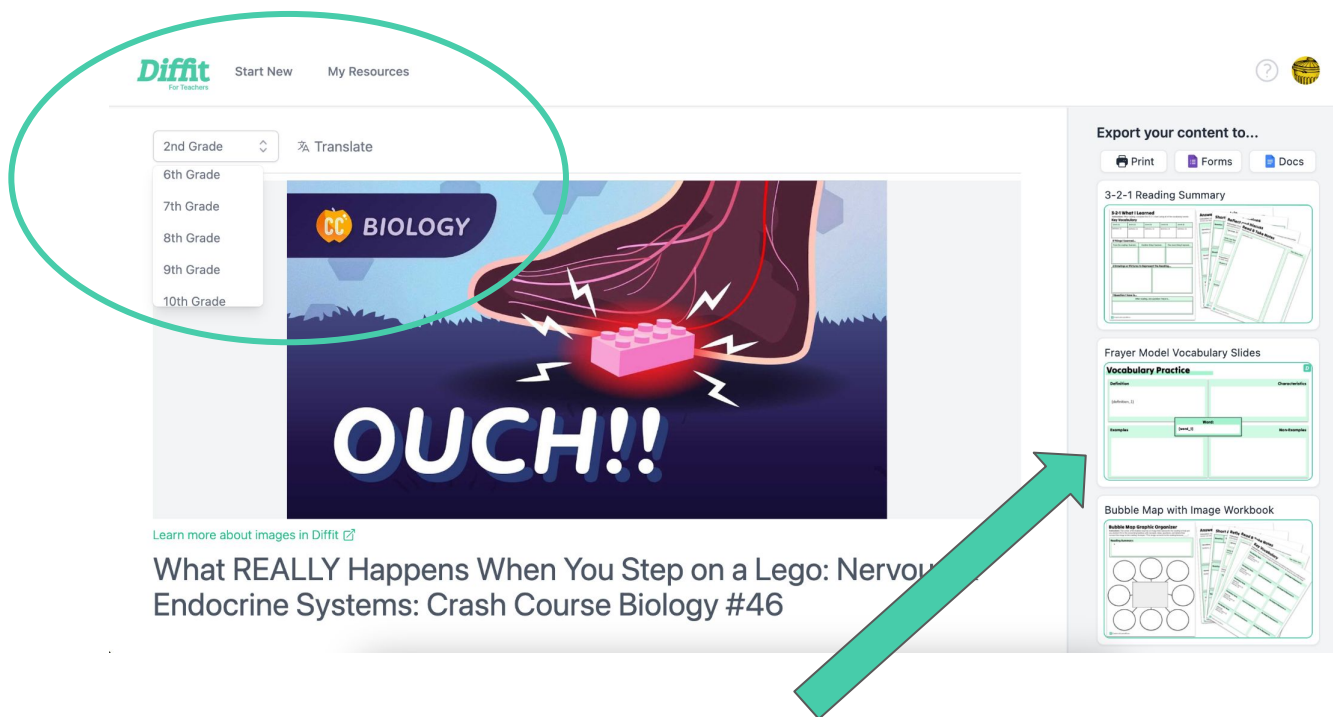

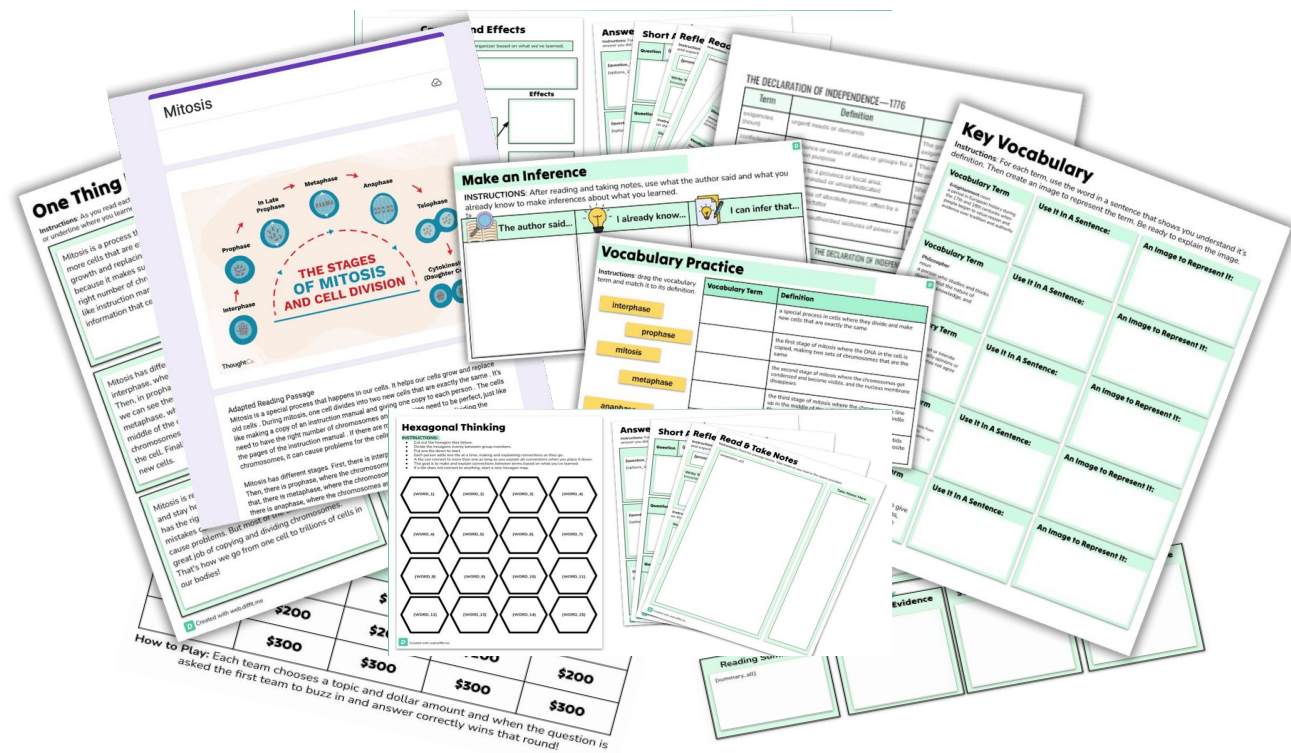

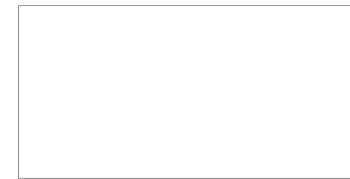
Viral Video



Instructions: Create a viral video script to summarize the main points of the text in a way that is engaging and concise. Highlight the most interesting or surprising elements to entice viewers to watch the video.

Key Points to Include:

1. **Hook:** Start with a question, a surprising fact, or a bold statement to draw viewers in.
2. **Main Idea:** Briefly explain the main idea or theme of the text.
3. **Highlights:** Mention 2-3 key highlights or interesting points from the text.
4. **Call to Action:** Encourage viewers to do something - what action to take - or just to like, share, and comment on the video.

Instructions: Read the text then respond with an emoji, hashtag and comment just like on social media! To express your reaction to the text, drag an emoji that visually represents your feelings into the circle. Next, use the title text box to assign a hashtag or title that highlights your reaction. 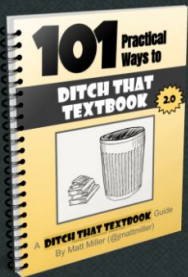
