- → Add clickable annotations and speech bubbles to any video that you upload
- → Autocorrect color, add color filters, and stabilize video images
- → Blur faces
- → Add copyright friendly audio
- → Upload caption files or transcripts



# **Curating: Search Effectively**


- → Use the browse and search functionality of YouTube to find channels and individual videos.
- → Use the Filters button to refine your query.
- → Create playlists for units that you teach. Set them up ahead of time or post-production. You can also create them on the fly.
- → Give links to playlists to students to supplement classroom materials.
- → Collect videos created by students to show to parents. Can use private links.






