Did You Know?

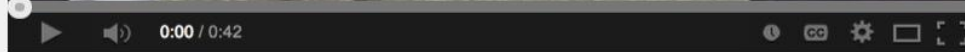
Online editing capabilities in YouTube continue to expand. (Go to your channel>video manager and select a video to edit.)

- Add clickable annotations and speech bubbles to any video that you upload
- Autocorrect color, add color filters, and stabilize video images
- Blur faces
- Add copyright friendly audio
- Upload caption files or transcripts

Curating: Search Effectively

- Use the browse and search functionality of YouTube to find channels and individual videos.
- Use the Filters button to refine your query.
- Create playlists for units that you teach. Set them up ahead of time or post-production. You can also create them on the fly.
- Give links to playlists to students to supplement classroom materials.
- Collect videos created by students to show to parents. Can use private links.



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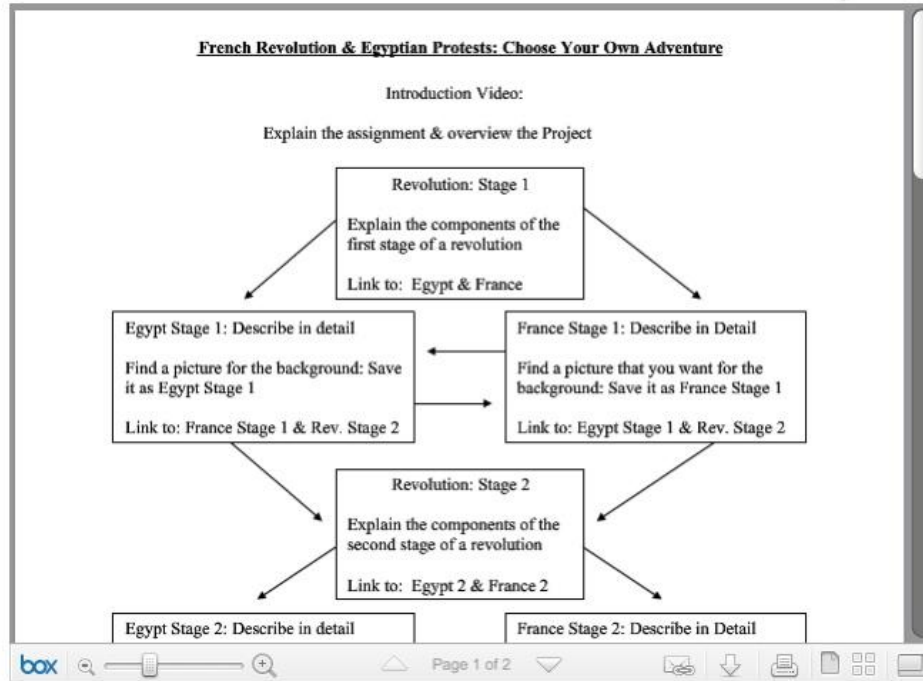


