










Bid-Rent Theory Explains how land value determines how a farmer will use the land...intensive or extensively




## Bid-Rent Theory

#### Land value high=

farmers use land <u>intensively</u> to produce as much as they can on limited land

#### Land value low= farmers use more land <u>extensively</u>


