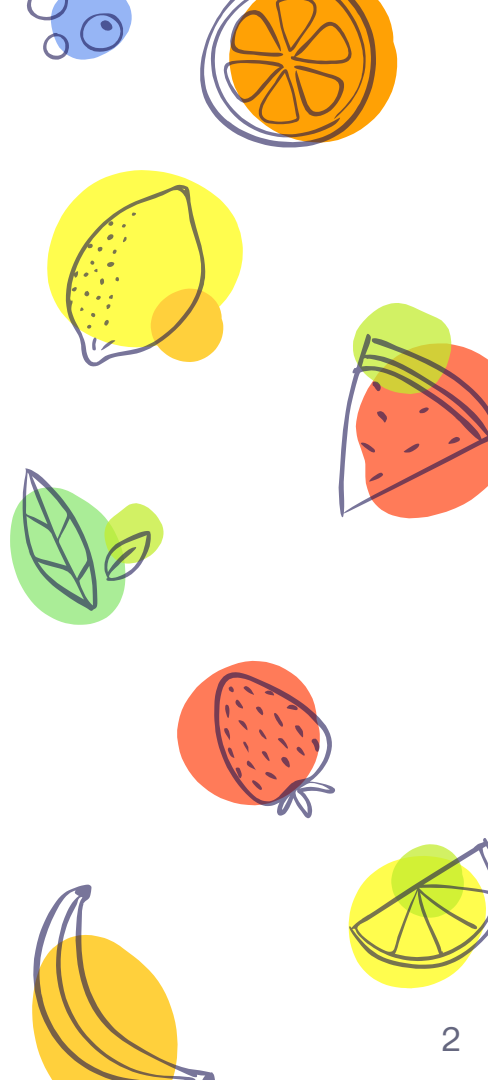

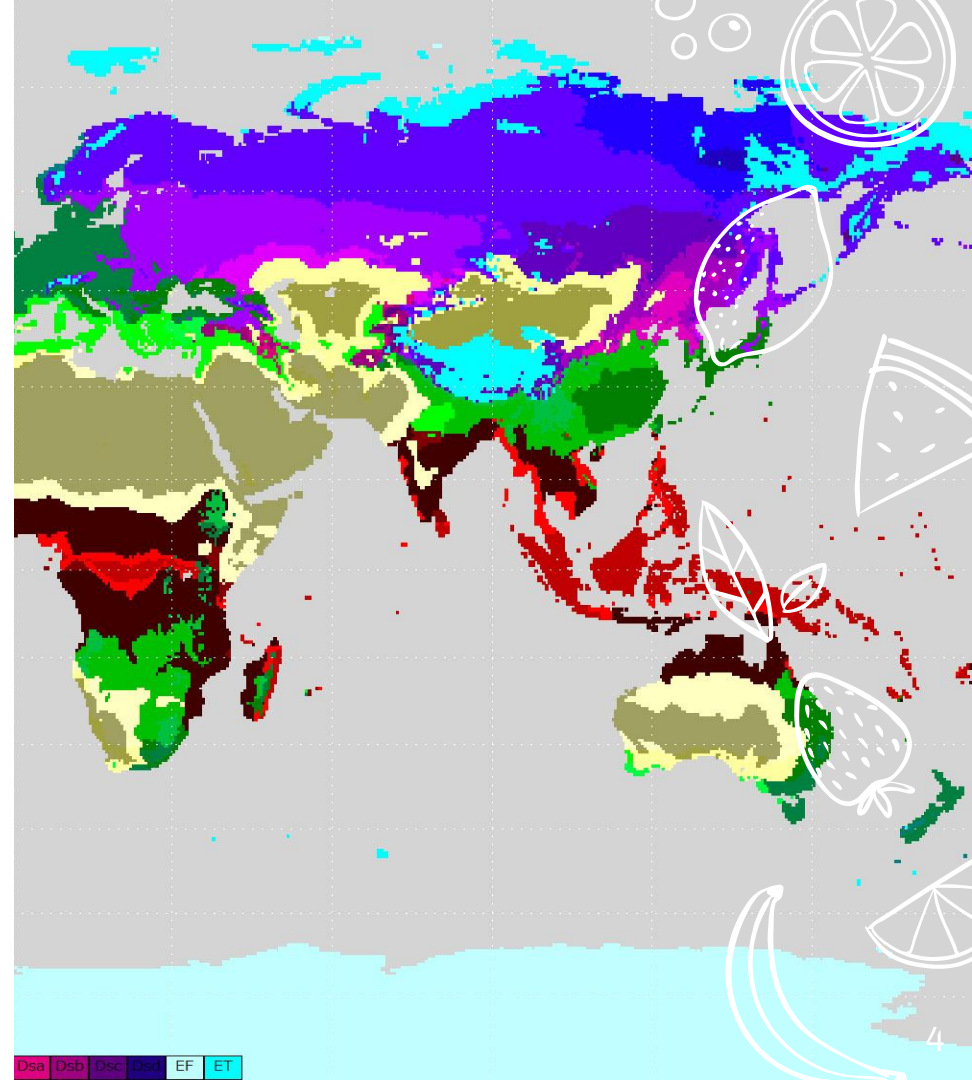

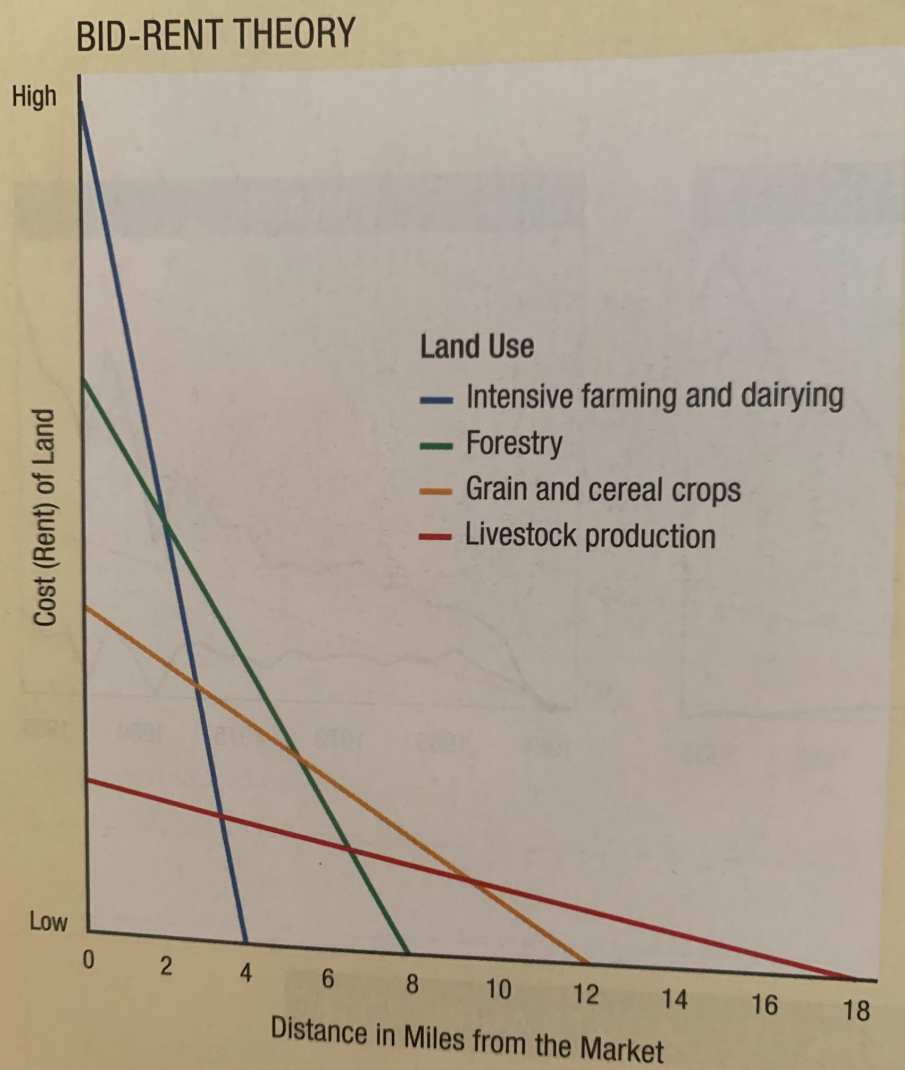

# Bid-Rent Theory

**Land value high=**  
farmers use land  
intensively to produce  
as much as they can on  
limited land

**Land value low=**  
farmers use more land  
extensively

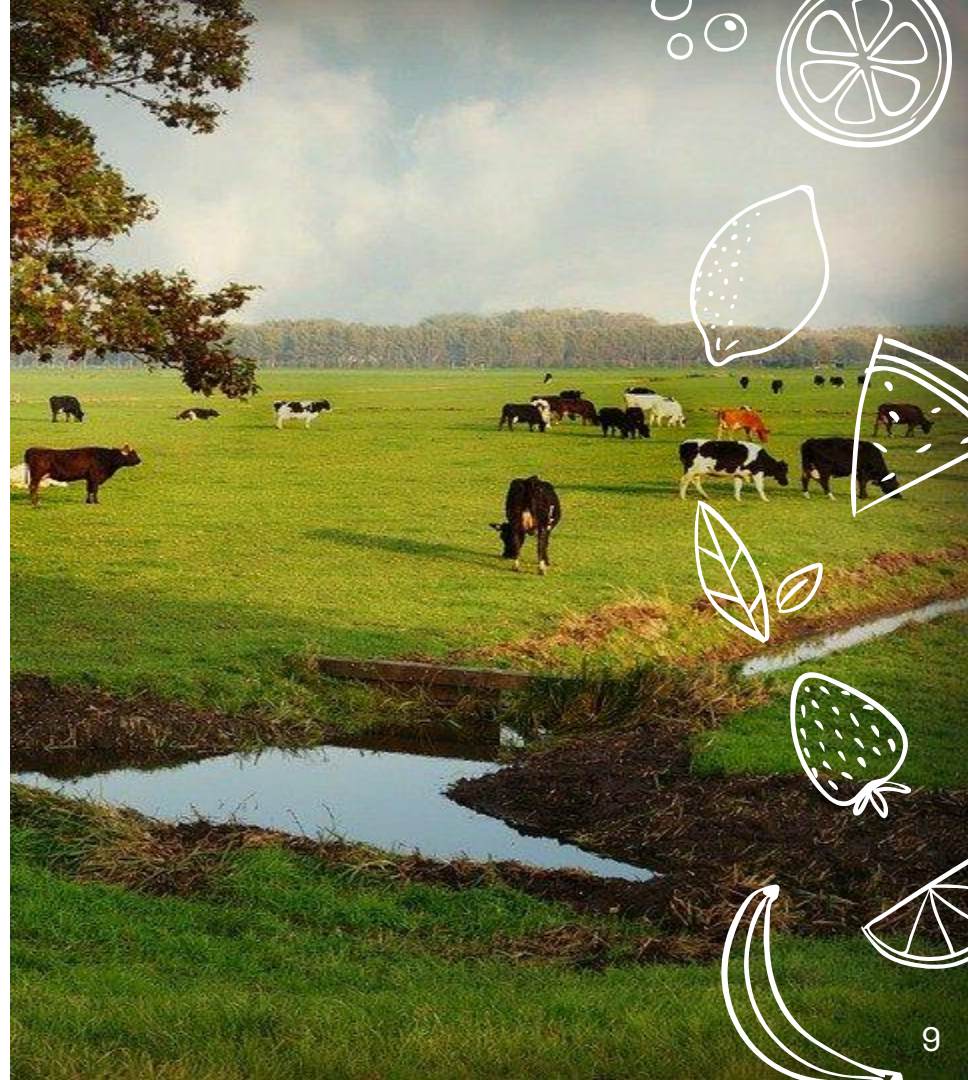
