

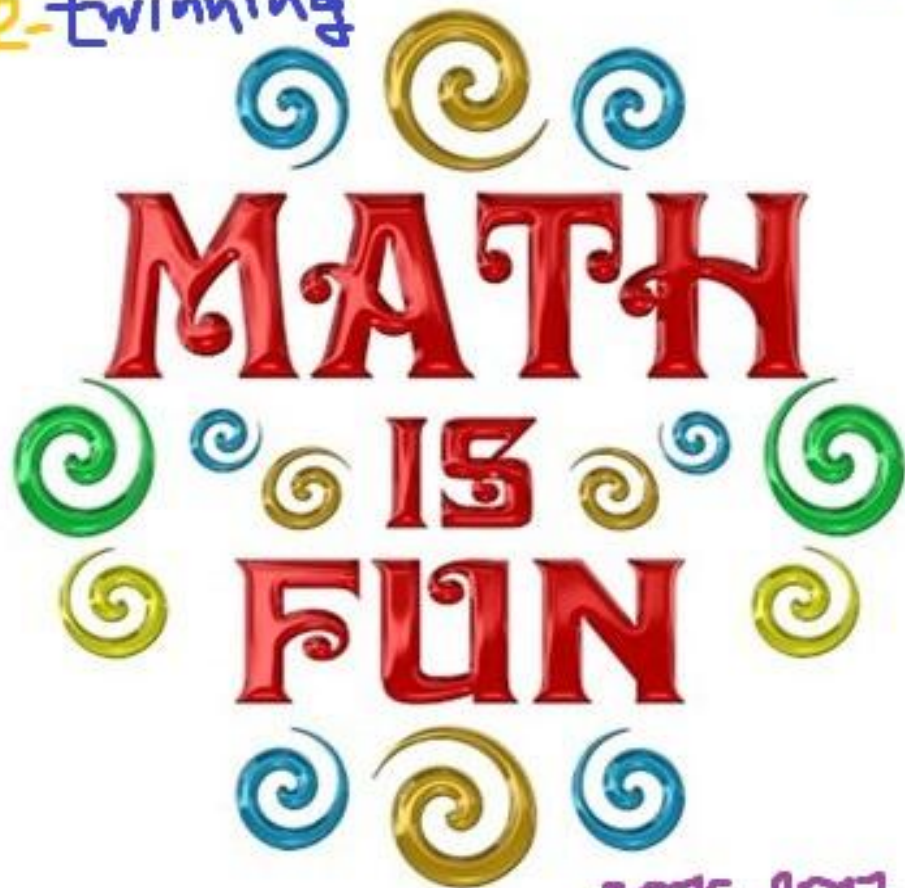

Then I let him go again.

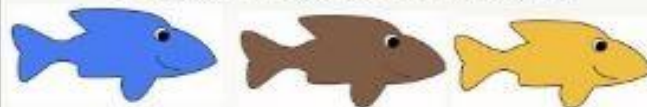


Why did you let him go?

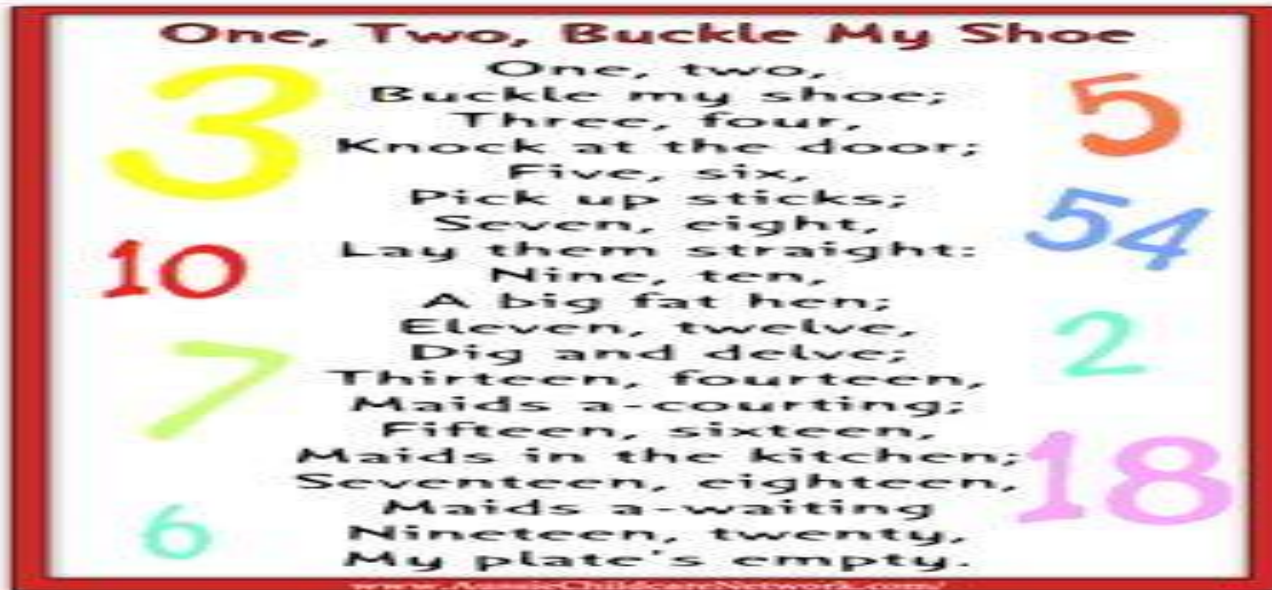

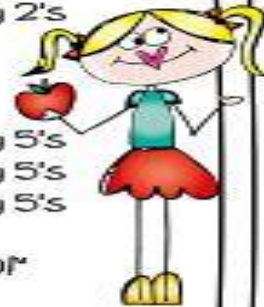
