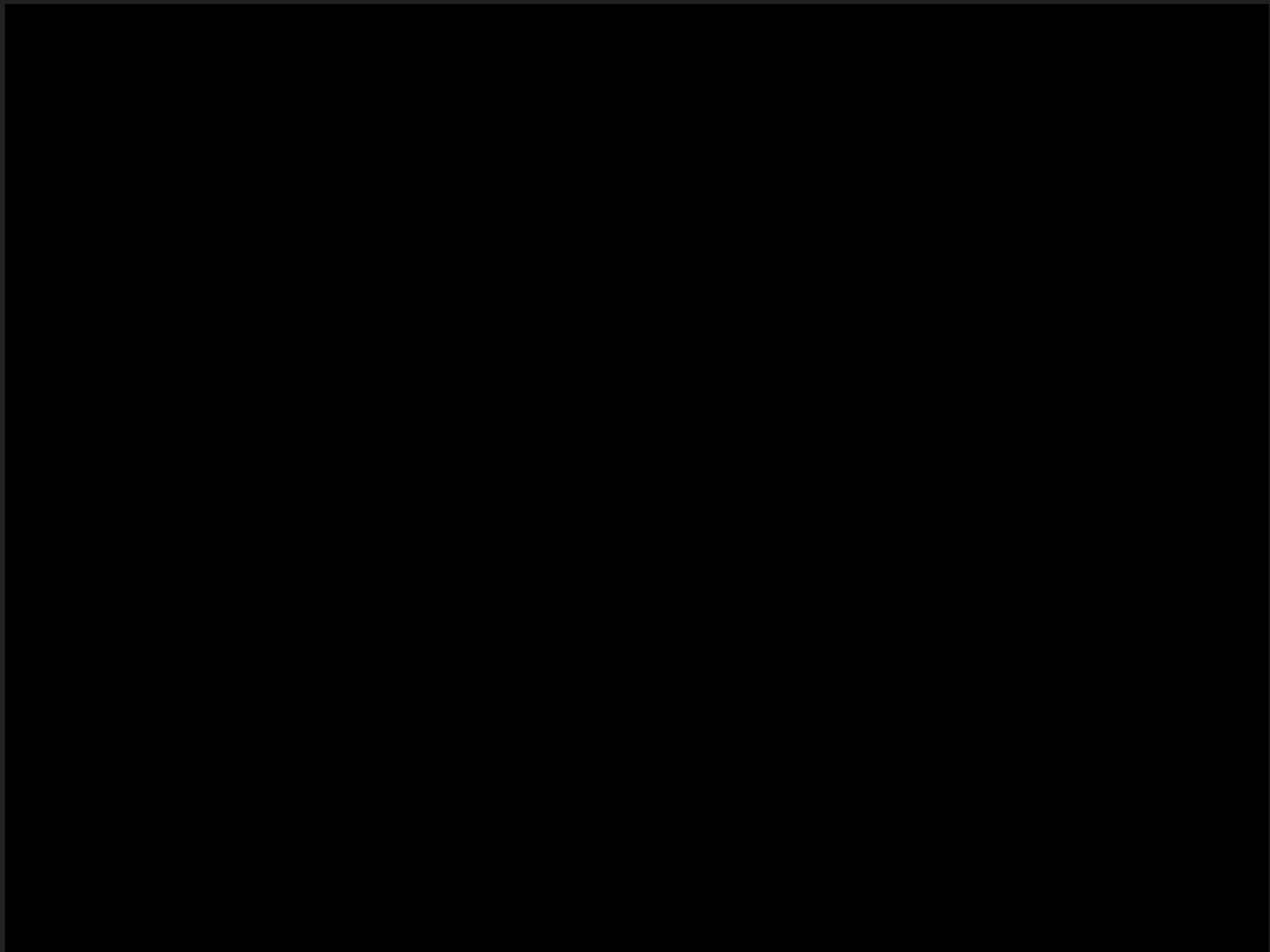
The Setting
