- Possibly emergent practice from EOSC: community proxy on top of an infrastructure proxy
- EOSC AAI Federation (cf. the 2022 working doc: https://docs.google.com/document/d/1L56uUvs9Tap1tlanendFm-_Jzfu6L7i7FYvzvsX1Mfk/edit)
- Possible work ahead: support “middlethings” (SP proxies) as a first class entity type in federation. SNCTFY-ish + transparency
- Peer or self-review based on AARC-G071 Attribute Authorities and Proxy Security
- Difficulties with projects that start out too small to have their own AAI or afford enterprise licenses from commercial vendors. Do we need more eduTeams-ish platforms with common capabilities, “domesticated applications”?
