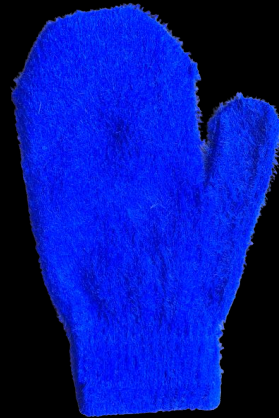

I see books.

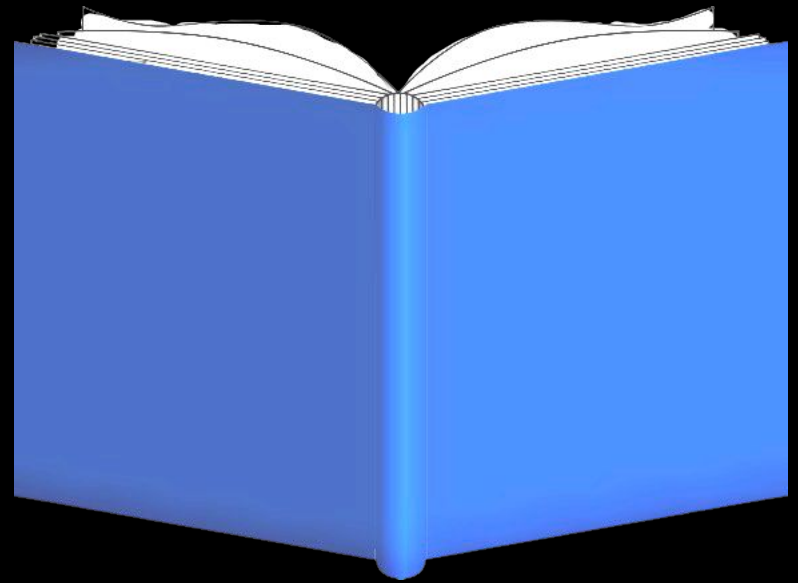
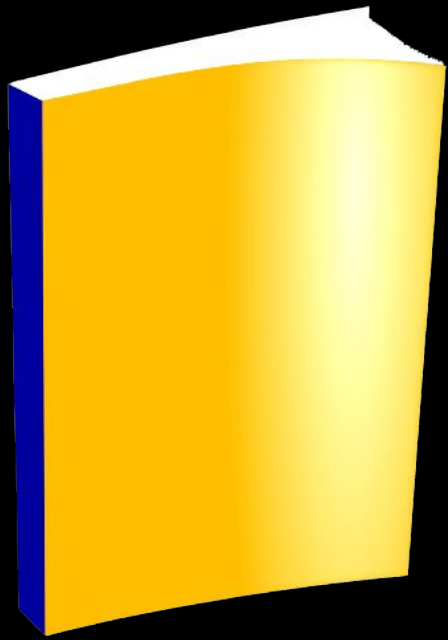
Books have a cover, pages, and a spine.

I see scissors.

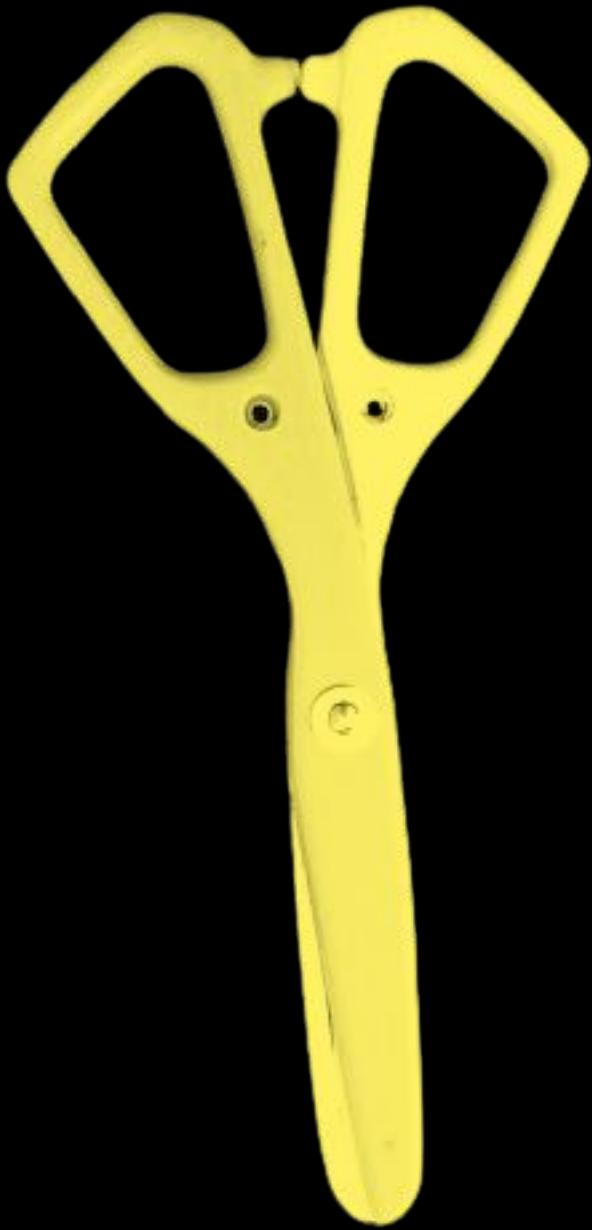
Scissors have two looped handles and two blades.
