



Verb - a verb is an action or being word.

Conjunction - a word used to connect clauses or sentences.

What is a verb?

Relating verbs

A **relating verb** is used to connect information or to show a relationship between words in a sentence.

What is a clause?

A clause is a group of words that has a **subject** and a **verb**.

Main Clause vs Dependent Clause

A **main clause** makes sense on its own. A **dependent clause** needs to be attached to a main clause, it <u>doesn't</u> make sense on its own.

dogs eat bones

when he arrives

What is a sentence?

A sentence is a group of words that express a complete thought.

Sentences begin with a capital letter and end with a full stop, a question mark or an exclamation mark.





Types of Sentences - Simple

Allow space in the corner for your webcam video

A simple sentence is a single main clause. It has a **subject** and a **verb**.

The giraffe stretched its tired legs.

Types of Sentences - Compound

Allow space in the corner for your webcam video

A compound sentence is a sentence that joins two main clauses together with a conjunction.

Jared didn't want to be late so he hurried to school.

I like to eat Iollies but they are bad for my teeth.



The students finished their work so they had a break.

Simple

Compound

This is a compound sentence because it has 2 main clauses - 'The students finished their work' and 'they had a break', and the clauses are joined with the conjunction 'so'.



The earth revolves around the sun.

Simple

Compound

This is a simple sentence because there is only one main clause (one complete thought).



He went to the fair and he went on all the rides.

Simple

Compound

This is a compound sentence because it has 2 main clauses - 'He went to the fair' and 'he went on all the rides', and the clauses are joined with the conjunction 'and'.

What is a conjunction?

A conjunction is a word used to connect clauses or sentences. A **coordinating conjunction** is used to join two main clauses together
