




Real Family Income Growth by Quintile 1979-2017




Median Annual Household Income by Race 1967-2018






Median Annual Earnings by Gender 1960-2017







Median Annual Earnings by Race & Gender 2018



Transgender Unemployment Rate by Race 2015




Real Family Income Growth by Quintile 1947-1979







Household Median Net Worth by Race 2016




Median Wealth Single Women & Single Men 2013




Share of Household Wealth in the U.S. 2016










Top Marginal Income Tax Rate for Top 1% 1947-2018








U.S. Federal Prison Population 1925-2017




U.S. Incarceration Rate by Race 2016




Deportations from the U.S. 1900-2017




Total Number of Foreign Born in U.S.




Percent of Foreign Born in U.S. 1870-2017









Median Annual Earnings by Race and Gender 2018



Women in Workforce vs. Low-Wage Workforce 2013




