Packing List - Bags

Packing List - Clothing


- COMFORTABLE walking shoes

Packing List – Hygiene

Packing List - Food

- Snacks (no chocolate or gum on the bus)

- All drinks should have a lid!!


All other meals will be provided!

Expectations - Bus

- You may leave things on the bus




Expectations - Adults

- Students will respect ALL adults (chaperones, bus drivers, restaurant employees, hotel employees, museum employees, and other tourists)
- Be respectful of small groups that may need to pass through
- Do not use electronic devices at museums, exhibits, memorials, etc. (especially when a guide is talking)
- Do not give money to or take pictures of strangers
- If there is a problem, locate a chaperone or school staff member immediately

Expectations - Chaperones

- Stay with your chaperone
- If given permission to leave chaperone, you must meet back at designated location ON TIME
- Do not leave the building that the chaperone is in **ever**
- Bring a buddy with you at all times



Expectations - Hotel

- Curfew will be announced upon arrival at the hotel (use ice/vending machines before)
- No one will leave room once the curfew begins (rooms will be taped closed)
- Security guard on site
- In case of an emergency, call hotel desk and ask for a DDMMS teacher



Expectations – Tuesday AM

- Tuesday morning will be early!
- Don't stay up too late on Monday.
- Do not leave your room until a DDMMS staff member removes the tape
- Get a good breakfast and be ready for a great day!
