# Getting rid of spoofer with DKIM

DomainKeys Identified Mail (**DKIM**) helps prevent spoofing by adding a digital signature to outgoing message headers

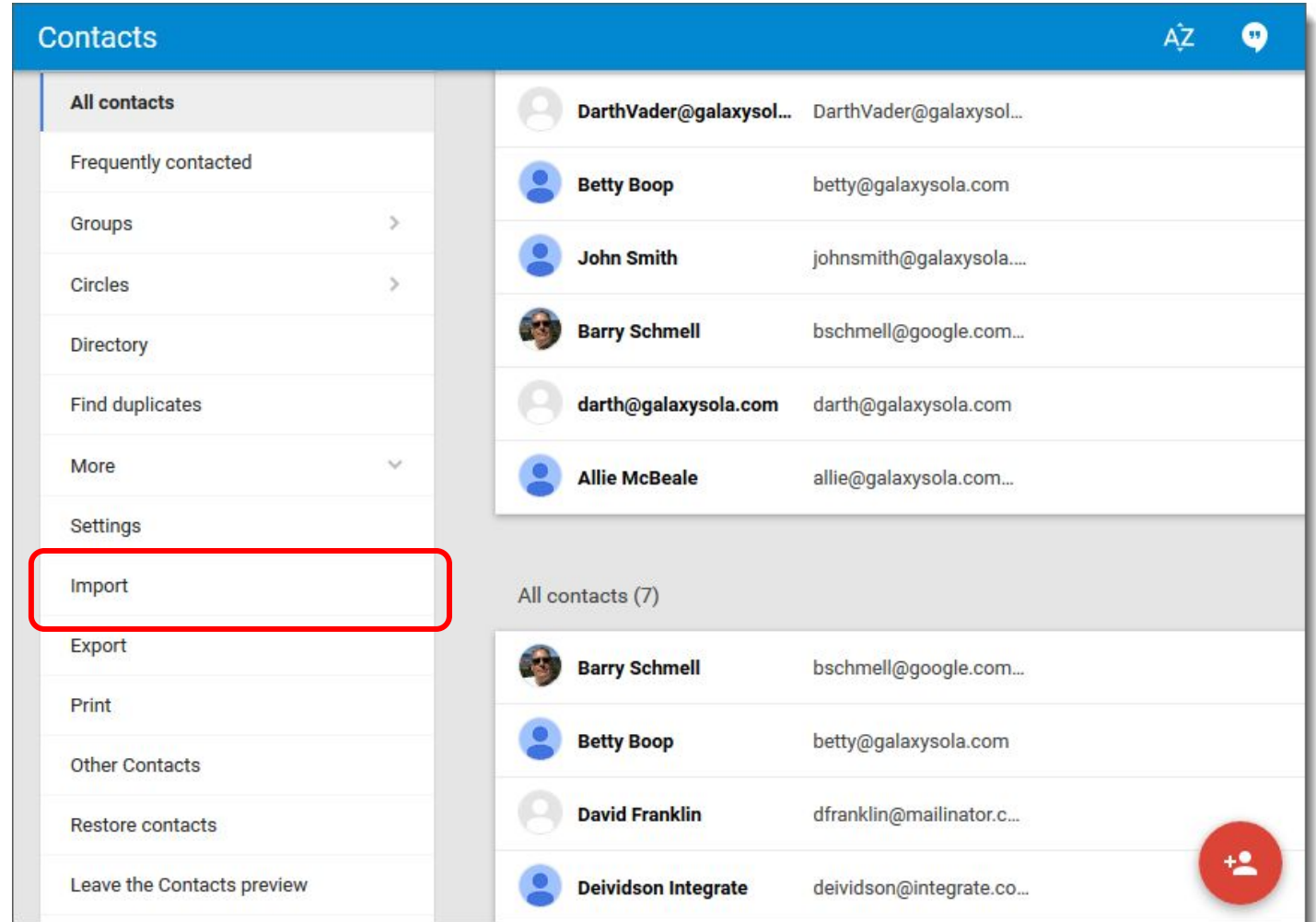


