- X Presentations graded by a teacher with a student audience
- X Formal presentations that require professional attire
- X <u>Timed</u> presentations

 - X This means you will have a minimum of 4 separate POLs

POL Norms

- X Every student presents to teachers who have a POL
- X Overall grade on POL is a separate grade on a student's transcript
- X POL performance <u>CAN</u> affect overall grade in the class (up or down)
- X Students who do not pass their POL will not have an opportunity to re-present



If you miss a POL, this is the process:

- Parent/guardian contacts the teachers who have been affected by the absence. Email is the preferred method of communication.
- Teacher(s) confirm receipt of the request for a presentation.
- Student schedules a time to meet with the teacher to discuss the missed presentation and potential make-up.
- Teachers determine if and when the student will present at a new date and time. If a make-up is scheduled, parent/guardian and student will be informed via email of the new date and time.



Professional Dress -

"Head, Shoulders, Knees & Toes"

- x HEAD: Hair should not cover the face; no hats
- SHOULDERS: Button-down dress shirt (shirt must be tucked in) or non-revealing blouse (must cover shoulders); Suit jacket (optional)
- x KNEES: Khaki pants or dress pants (no jeans);
 Dress or skirt that touches tops of knees when standing up straight
- x TOES: Closed-toe dress shoes (no sneakers or excessively high heels)



Guardians, families, and special guests are welcome to attend a student's POL

We request that you notify your student's teacher in advance if you are planning to attend to be sure that the presentation date and time is accurate. Please bring ID and check-in at the reception desk on the first floor before proceeding to the 3rd floor for the presentation. Please allow at least 15 minutes to park, check-in, and travel to the 3rd floor. Every effort will be made to run presentations on time, and presentations will not be delayed to wait for a parent, quardian, or special quest to arrive.
