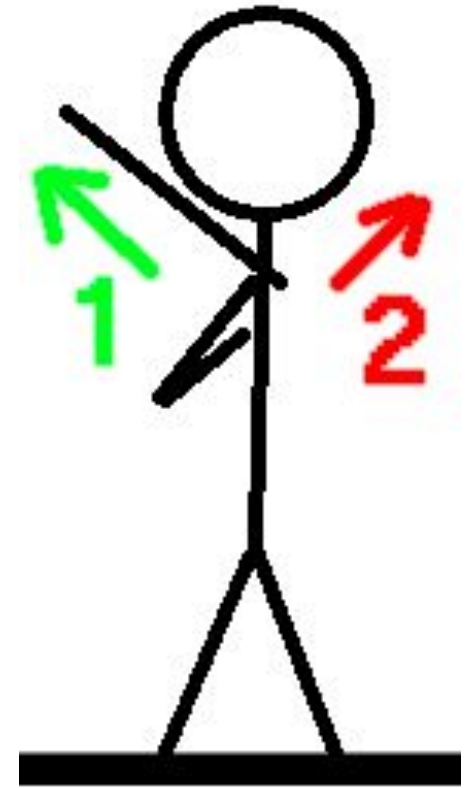

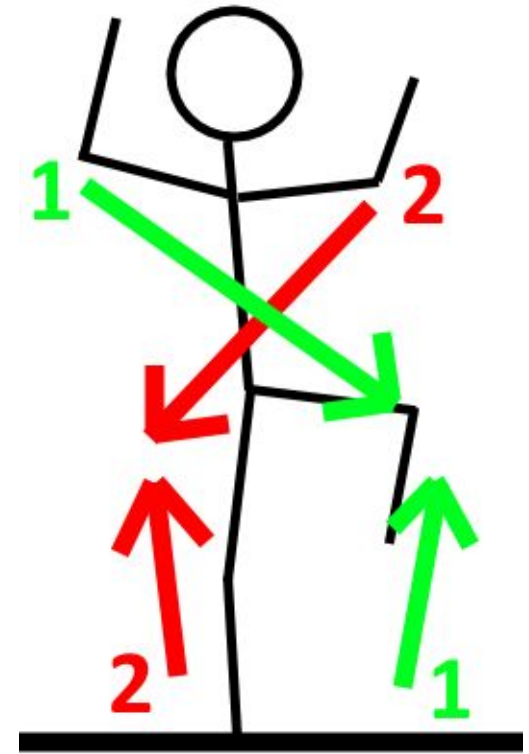

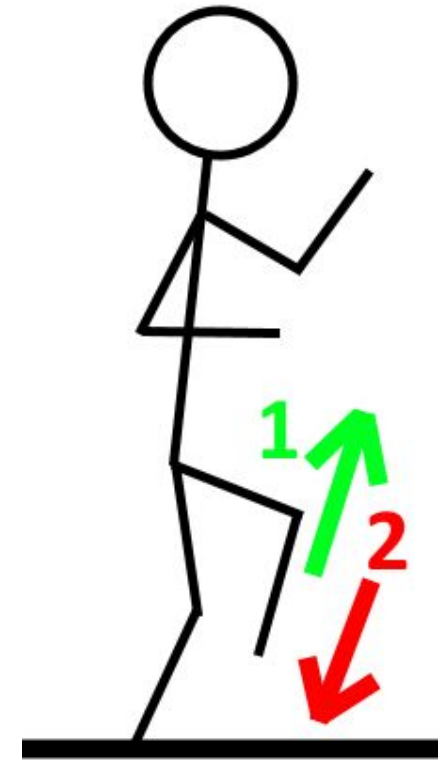
My eyes glow in the dark night.

what I might be?



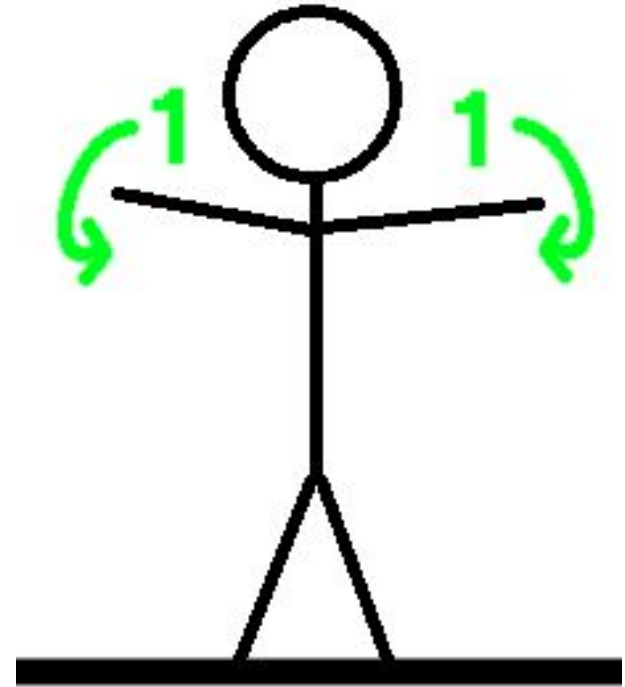
I fly through the night. I can't see too well. I have a magic wand, I use for my spell. I have a black cat named Midnight, don't you see. I wonder if you could figure out me.



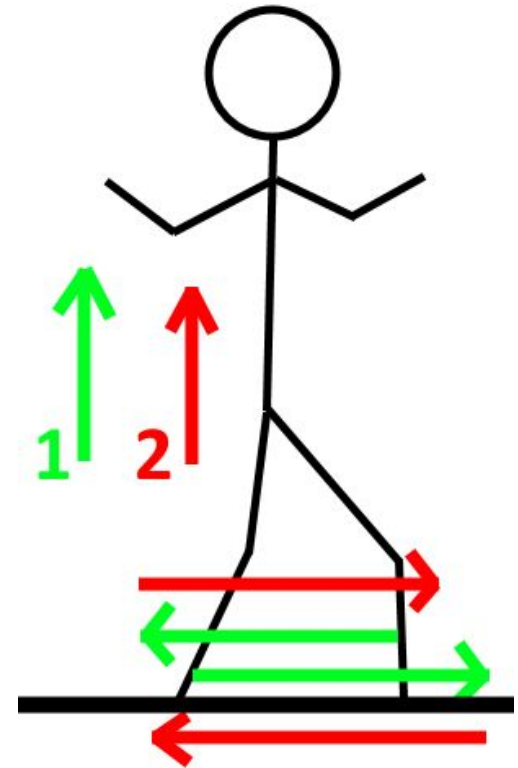
I like to live in a very dark place.

people don't give me any hugs.



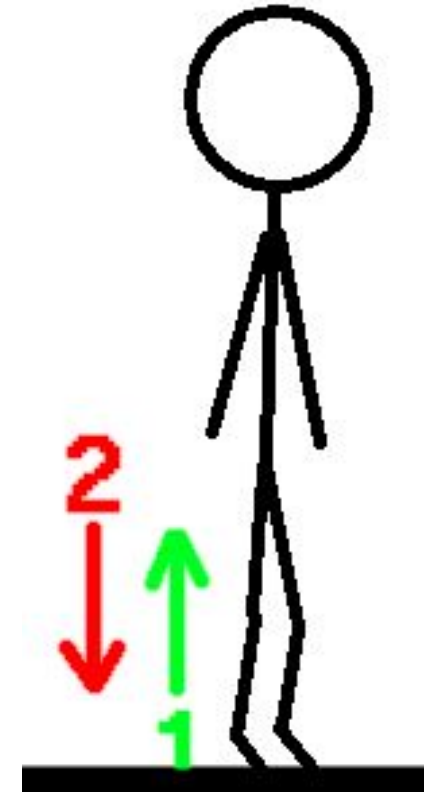
I live in an old broken down house. The only thing that lives there with me is a mouse. I float through the air in a sheet made of white. I give most people an awful fright.

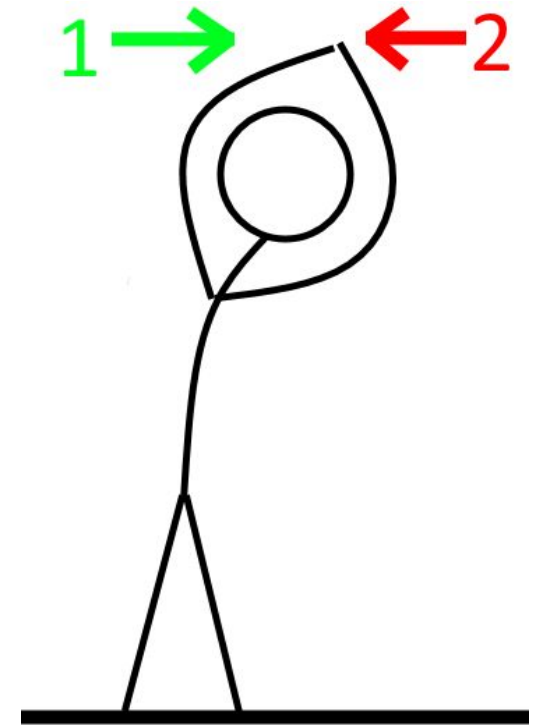
Kids like to eat me all year round.

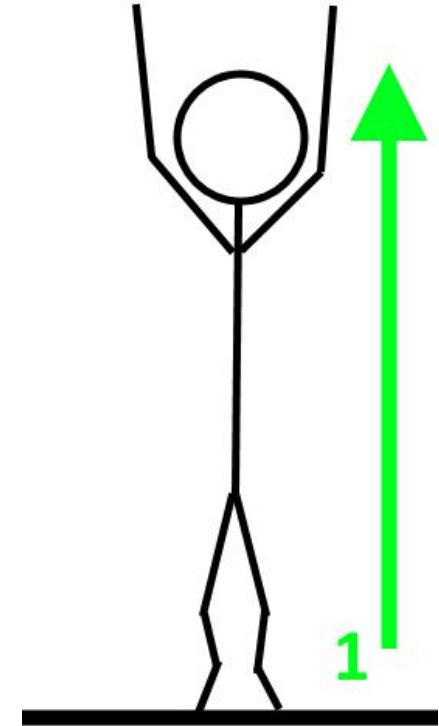
I sometimes live under your bed.

only wish I could be your friend.



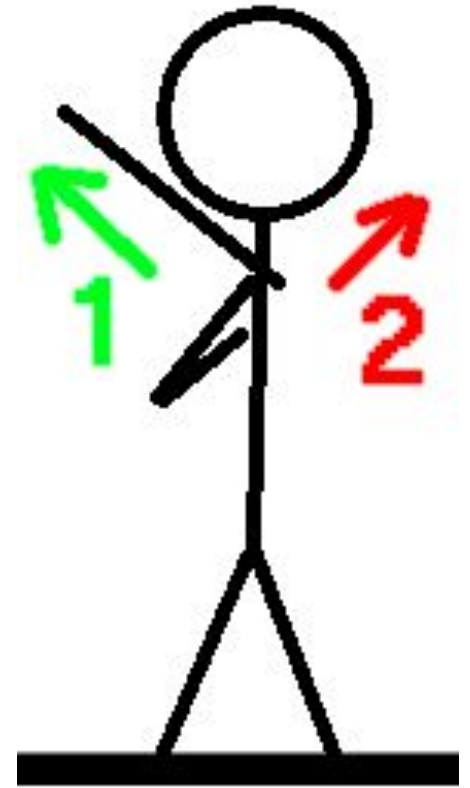

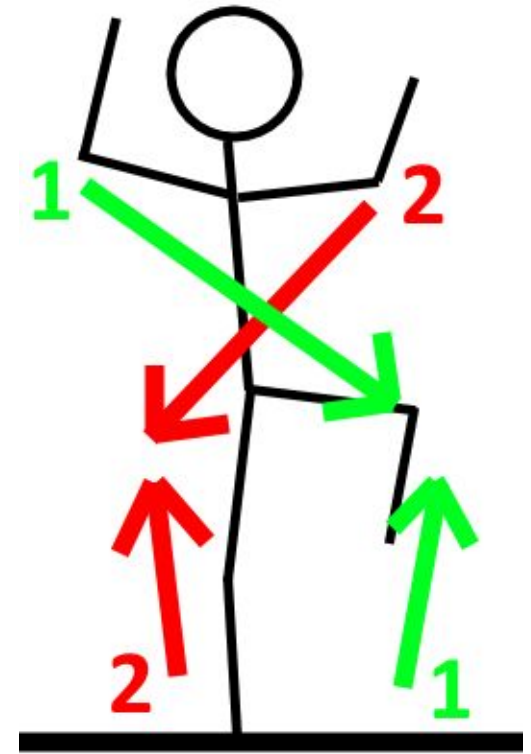
I shine up in the sky all glowing bright. Sometimes I am full on Halloween night. I move about and light the way for you. I am shaped like a circle and a fingernail too.



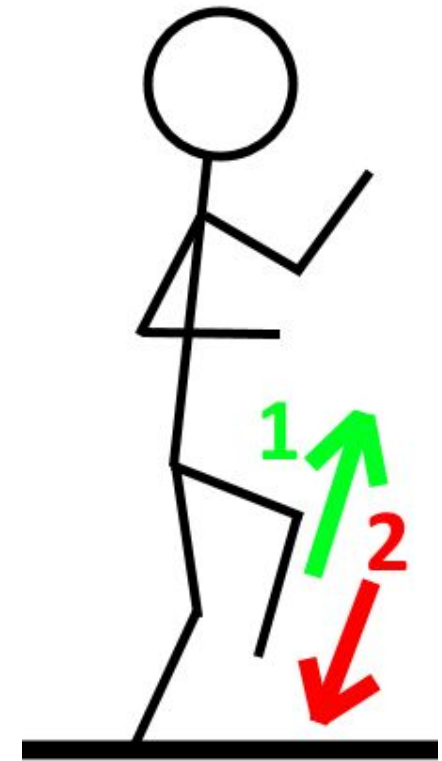

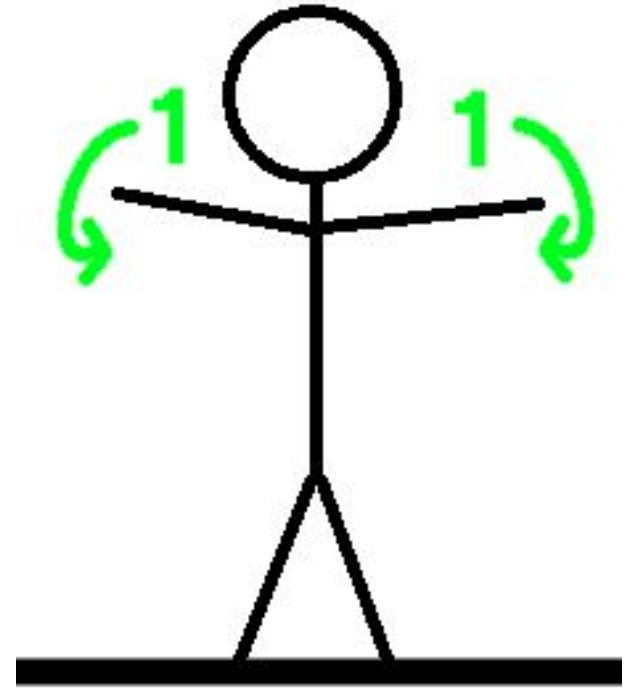

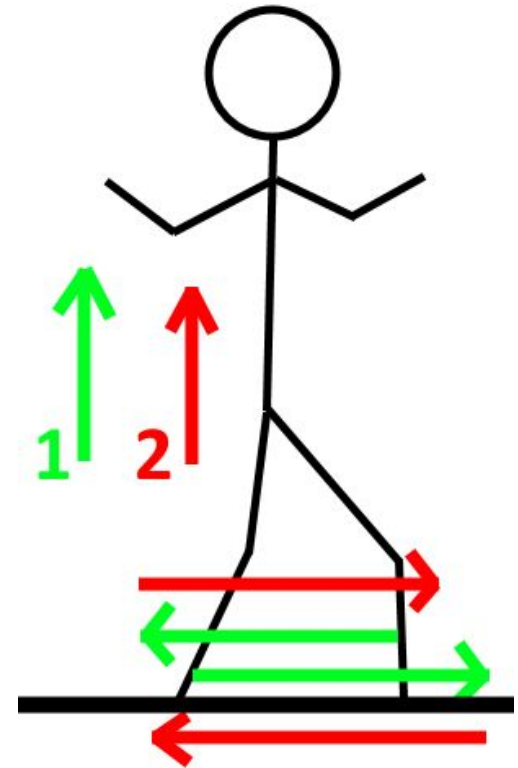
I shine in the night and sparkle a bit. I am pretty to look at and I am always lit. When the clouds are not out, I am easy to see. Do you think you might know me?



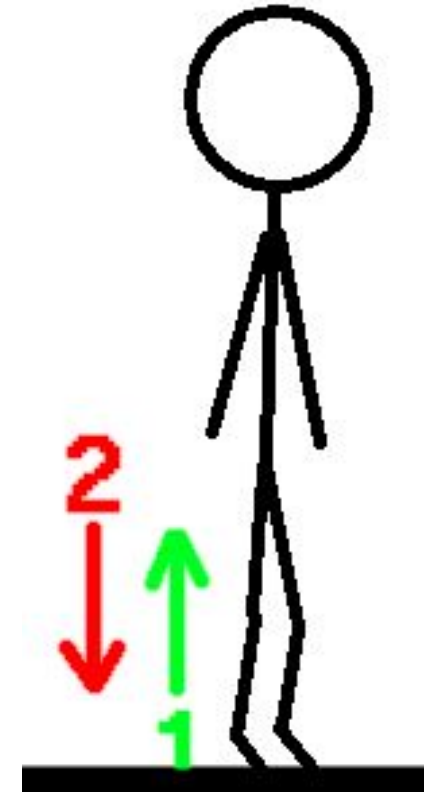
I can be your pet, but some people don't like me. They think I'm bad luck and I'm not don't you see. I just purr and scratch and I'm as lovable as can be.



You wear me on Halloween as you go house to house. I might be a witch, or a monster, or mouse. I come in so many choices to choose. I cover your body from head to your shoes.

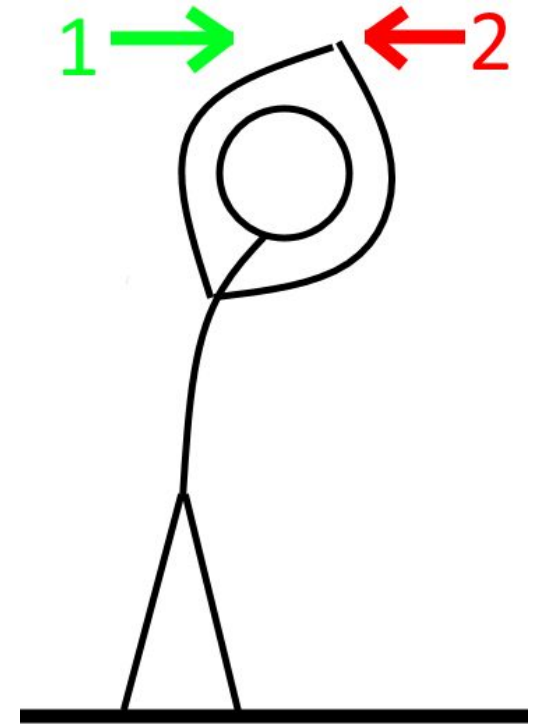


I float through the sky on windy days. I am very colorful in many ways. People rake me up and jump in my piles. I create a fall scene that is a beautiful surprise.

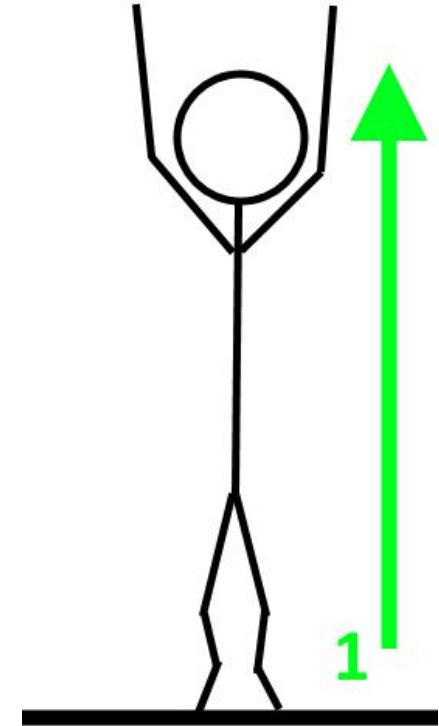
I am old and broken down with lots of cobwebs. I might even have a broken down bed. My windows are cracked and my sidewalk is old. I am a place no one wants to go.

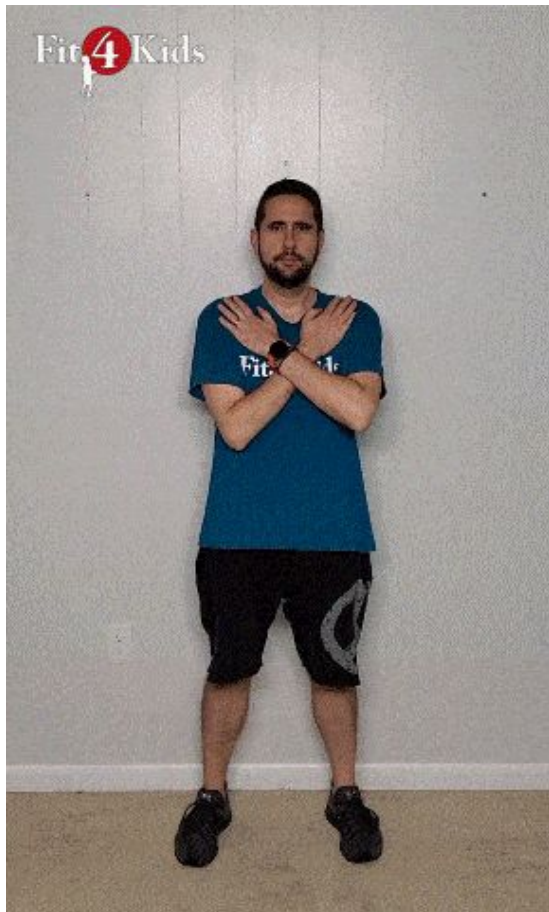

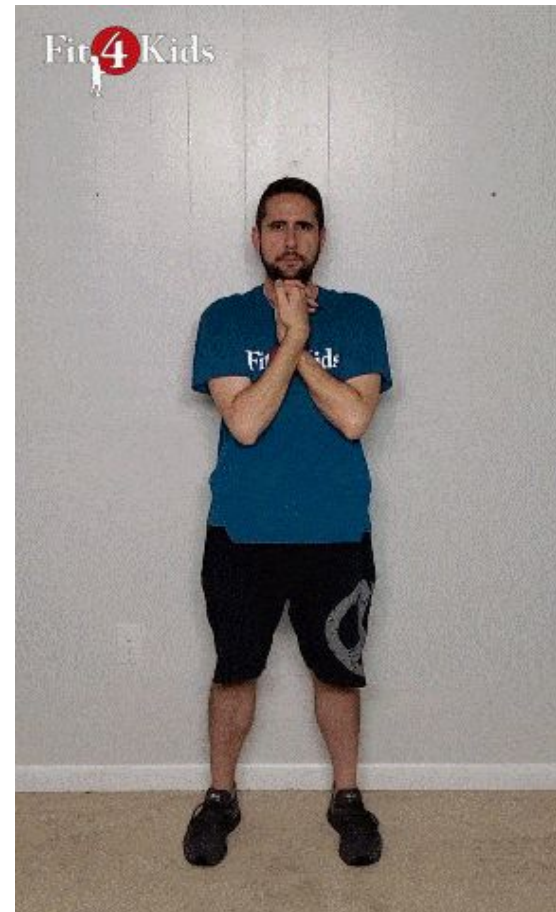
