Potential Bylaw Amendment: Adding a Vice Chair



The Vice Chair of the Graduate and Postdoctoral Education Across Disciplines SIG will be elected for a term of one year and will hold principal responsibility for the selection, presentation, and distribution for the awards of the Graduate and Postdoctoral Education Across Disciplines SIG. In the event that the Graduate and Postdoctoral Education Across Disciplines SIG Chair is unable, or unavailable to perform their duties the Vice Chair will assume the role of "Interim Chair" after a majority vote of the Graduate and Postdoctoral Education Across Disciplines SIG Executive Board. The board shall inform the memberships of the SIG of such a vote prior to it occurring. In this event, the Vice Chair shall also be tasked with the responsibilities and authorities of Chair (refer to Article VII, Section 1), including but not limited to monitoring, encouraging the growth of, and reporting to the SIG on membership issues, as well as establish pathways for mentorship opportunities between junior and senior members. In the event of such a vote the Vice Chair serves as Interim Chair until the term of the Chair expires or the Chair has been reinstated. The Vice Chair retains all duties and responsibilities of the Vice Chair while serving as Interim Chair unless the board appoints a replacement.



Program Chair - Job Description

The Program Co-Chairs shall be responsible for:

- promoting, if appropriate, the Annual Meeting's "theme" established by the AERA President when encouraging his/her SIG members to submit proposals.
- becoming adept at using AERA's on-line system for proposal submission/review by attending the web-based training session for Program Chairs.
- recruiting reviewers
- assigning reviewers to proposals
- ensuring that each submitted proposal receives a fair and unbiased review (by a minimum of two reviewers) by the deadline established by AERA. making a final accept/reject decision for each proposal by the deadline established by AERA.
- encouraging members of his/her SIG to volunteer and serve as Chairs and Discussants.
- making sure that sessions are created by the deadline established by AERA.
- overseeing all aspects of the program preparation process such that his/her SIG's portion of the Annual Meeting is of the highest quality possible.

Program Co-Chair: Requirements

- The full name of each candidate;
- The institutional affiliation of each candidate;
- The email address of each candidate;
- A biographical statement for each candidate, which can be a maximum of 200 words.

AERA policy requires that all elections be competitive; that is, there must be two or more candidates for each elected office.

- Only <u>Regular, Voting Members</u> of AERA can run for office. Graduate students can only run for positions designated for graduate students (e.g., Graduate Student Representative).
- · Candidates must be current members of the SIG and of AERA to appear on the ballot.
- No individual can serve for more than three consecutive years in any one officer role. (Please note that your SIG's bylaws may have additional restrictions regarding term limits.)
