## Re-introducing ourselves

What has RemotelyGreen already done

#### 1. Project status, THE Port Project Vision

- Literature review: collected documents and links on the topic. Summarized for each other
- Questionnaire: 333 people responded
- Prototype webpage:
   <a href="https://sarazahedinezhad.wixsite.com/mysite-2">https://sarazahedinezhad.wixsite.com/mysite-2</a>? Main functionality: CO2 calculator for travel vs video conferencing, tool recommendation
- Stenogram: Video conferencing to text + summary. Working prototype. Interviewed CTO of <u>Allo-media</u> during hackathon. Clear market opportunity.
- Final presentation: Slide deck and recording of presentation



#### 1. Project status, Climathon Project Vision

- Case study for a typical UN event: One day UN Meeting in Geneva: 200 delegates, 6 hour meeting. In person (transport, hotel): 371 t. Via video (device, server, lifetime product analysis): 1 13 t = 96.2% reduction in CO2 using video
- Implementing the calculator: Convert this paper into executable code. Now on github:
   https://github.com/benkrikler/video-conf-calculator
   connected to web-page yet
- Planning a fully virtual event: Sustainable Development Goals Innovation Day
- Lots of networking: Several people from the UN, University of Geneva, Tsinghua University in China, Geneva Impact Hub

## GLOBAL GOALS INNOVATION DAY

#### Key points:


- Charge fee proportional to GDP per capita
- Pre-record talks: subtitled, indexed, searchable
- Realtime Q&A around the talks with speakers included
- Networking virtual coffee breaks: random, recommended, requested, reversed
- Quantified outcomes: CO2 saved, time spent, number of people / ideas encountered

- What is the most efficient meeting frequency? (once a month? Once a week? Only when <u>necessary</u>? If so, define necessary.)

Back to the big picture: Draft Vision and Mission

#### Big picture aspects

Help us focus down what we will do and why

- Outwardly: clarify what we're doing
- Inwardly: guide decision making and goal setting

Help us to clarify what we're working towards:

- The Vision: A mix of what and why. What is our high-level objective?
- The Mission: A sense of how. What will do to realise our vision?

# The mission?

Enable innovation for remote collaboration

Encourage open collaboration between members of the collective

Be financially sustainable as an organisation

Change the culture so people travel less and have more effective meetings
