



Present simple

(HE/SHE/IT)

In the simple present for he/she/it we need to add «s» or «es» to the verb.

Let's see the rules

01

General rule

You have to add «s» at the end of the verb.

He works
She begins
It runs

02

Second rule

You have to add «es» at the end of the verb. When the verbs finish by:

1. -ch
2. -ss,
3. Sh
4. -o
5. -x

He goes

She washes

It watches

He fixes

She guesses

Spelling rules

03

Third rule

When a verb finishes by a consonant and «y» you have to change the «y» into «i» then you have to add «es» --- «ies»

EXAMPLES:

He (study) ----- He studies

She (carriy)-----She carries

It (fly) ----- It flies
