Present simple (HE/SHE/IT)

In the simple present for <u>he/she/it</u> we need to add «s» or «es» to the verb.


Let's see the rules

You have to add «s» at the end of the verb.

He work<u>s</u> She begin<u>s</u> It runs

When a verb finishes by a consonant and «y» you have to change the «y» into «i» then you have to add «es» --- «ies»

> EXAMPLES: He (stu<u>dy</u>) ----- He stud<u>ies</u> She (car<u>ry</u>)----- She carr<u>ies</u> It (fl<u>y</u>) ----- It fl<u>ies</u>
